DISCOUNTS AND WHOLESALE PRICES

On orders over \$5.00 you may select extra bulbs or bulblets to the value of 10% of your order; over \$10.00, 20%; over \$20.00, 30%; over \$35.00, 40%; over \$50.00, 50%. These discounts do not apply on special assortments or mixtures, which are priced according to amounts ordered.

Our liberal discounts are adjusted to give the larger buyers wholesale prices, instead of issuing a separate list. Our prices per 100 and 1000 are as low as can be made, considering the discounts given, and that we send

BULBS OF QUALITY

Our crop of bulbs is the finest we have ever grown; large, clean, high-crowned, and properly cured to

grow the best spikes of bloom. Not a thrip in a carload.

All varieties listed have been thoroughly tested, and are the best of their color. As it is impossible to grow all varieties, we discard a few each year to make room for newer and better ones. If you desire any we listed last year, and do not find them in our list, write us early; we may be able to supply them, as we are retaining several varieties to plant early for cut flowers.

LARGE bulbs are 11/4 inches and up to 3 inches diameter, and are generally considered best for exhibition

purposes, producing the best flowers on longest spikes.

MEDIUM size bulbs, 34 inch to 114 inches, give a very satisfactory spike, with florets usually as large

as from larger bulbs.

SMALL bulbs, 3% inch to 34 inch, are planted for increase rather than blooms, but if not planted too late, most varieties will bloom.
