## SUMMARY OF STATE INSPECTOR'S REPORT

November 16, 1933

## THE PFEIFFER NURSERY

 Winona, MinnesotaI do not see how we could possibly do anything more to assure ourselves that your bulbs are free from thrips. The reasons for making this statement are as follows:

1. During the summer of 1932 your fields were thoroughly inspected by our inspectors and your experts for infestations of thrips. During the whole season no infestations whatsoever were found.
2. The bulbs in your cellar were given a thorough examination for thrips and found to be absolutely free. This examination included microscopic and general observation of the trays.
3. A thorough fumigation with Cyanogas was conducted to doubly assure us that no infestation would be carried out with the bulbs during shipping season. This was not necessary according to observations throughout the season but in order to be absolutely sure the fumigation was made.
4. Specimens of bulbs from various parts of your cellar were taken back to University Farm for examination for thrips and to date no infestations have been found on these bulbs. I do not know what more anyone could do to be sure the stock of bulbs was free from thrips infestation.
