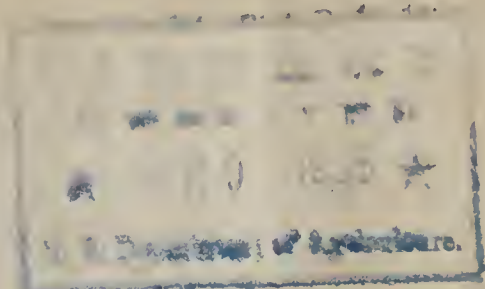

Red Ruffles (Arenius) red, with extremely ruffled blooms, opening 8, wide open form, straight spike, midseason. Unlike most ruffled varieties this has a long flower spike of 20 buds and many showing color.
