

COMBINATIONS WITH TULIPS AND OTHER SPRING BULBS

Breeder Bacchus with Cottage Tulip Moonlight, with Anchusa Myosotidiflora as foreground or Nepeta Mussini as a foliage border.

Breeder Prince of Orange very nice with Godet Parfait, Louis XIV or Bacchus with a few Cottage Tulip Mother's Day. Cottage Tulip Grenadier with White Emperor and Anchusa Myosotidiflora.

Any of the violet and purple shades of Tulips make a good foreground for White Lilacs, using bright yellow Violas as a border for the Tulips.

Tulipa Greigi with Single Early Tulip White Swan and light blue Crocus at the base.

Cottage Tulip Moonlight and Scarlet Emperor with Anchusa Myosotidiflora.

Clara Butt Tulips in foreground of Persian Lilacs.

Hyacinth City of Haarlem with Single Early Tulip de Wet

Combine white and yellow; white and pink; white, blue and yellow.

When using red, use cool blue to soften it.

Combine yellow and lavender: Rev. Ewbank Darwin Tulips with Inglescombe Yellow.

Combine yellow Tulips with Bleeding Hearts.

Combine white with gold and bronze.

White and other light shades lend perspective in the background; use darker shades in the foreground.

Phlox Subulata bloom with the Early Tulips

Flowering Crap Apples bloom with the Tulips.

Tulipa Kaufmanniana blooms with Chionodoxa, Crocus and Scilla.

Narcissus Spring Glory blooms with Grape Hyacinths and Scilla Siberica.

Viburnum Carlesi blooms with Darwin, Breeder and Cottage Tulips.

Prunus Triloba blooms with Early Tulips and Narcissi.
