The minimum weight for freight shipments is 100 pounds. Express rates for shipments weighing more than 100 pounds are proportional; for less than 100 pounds there is a sliding scale which will be quoted upon application.

Our No. 1 grade roses packed with moss for freight or express weigh about 70 pounds per 100. About 30,000 plants can be loaded in a refrigerator car.

FREE PACKING—We do not charge for packing, boxing and material.

EXPRESS — All stock packed light with paper in veneer boxes for express shipment unless ordered for paper packing; however, we advise the former method since it keeps the roses in the best condition. Unless quantity is sufficient for box packing, roses will be packed with paper.

GRADE NO. 1—This is a regular grade. Teas and Hybrid Teas, Polyanthas, about 18 inches and up; Climbers and Hybrid Perpetual, about 24 inches and up and three or more branches.

GRADE NO. 1½—This is a light grade, suitable for mailing or potting. Teas and Hybrid Teas about 12 inches and up; climbers and Hybrid Perpetuals, about 18 inches and up, two or more branches.

CLAIMS—Before receipting for the shipment, examine it to see if apparently in good shape. If there is any complaint to make, the same must be forwarded to us immediately upon receipt of the plants. It is mutually agreed to between the purchaser and ourselves that we shall not at any time be liable for any amount greater than the original purchase price of the stock.
