These prices are those prevailing at the time of going to press, and those which we hope to be able to maintain throughout the planting season. However, these prices are subject to change without notice, as all orders will be accepted at the prices prevailing on the date the order is received, and subject to stock being unsold.

Due to some crop failures, caused by the severe drought of last summer, there are some items that are not priced, as we are sold out, or were unable to secure stocks to enable us to sell at this time. Values on other items have climbed to new heights, due to the shortages, and we can only offer these at present values. If you secured these varieties early at the prices prevailing during the early part of last summer, you should sell according to the present values.

We are sending with this Price List our new edition of our Garden Guide. This book gives the descriptions of nearly all the varieties listed in this Price List. Hence we felt that it was not necessary to repeat. The Garden Guide is available for distribution to your trade, the same as the Corn Manual. If you place an order with us, we will be glad to supply you with a quantity to give to your customers. Should you desire a large number imprinted with your name and address we would be pleased to give you a price.

Look into your requirements for seeds and allied lines today, and send us your order, so that when the demand is made for seeds you will have your supply on hand. Our representative will call on you during the spring and summer, soliciting your order for 1936 delivery.
