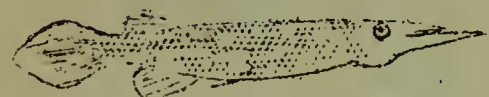

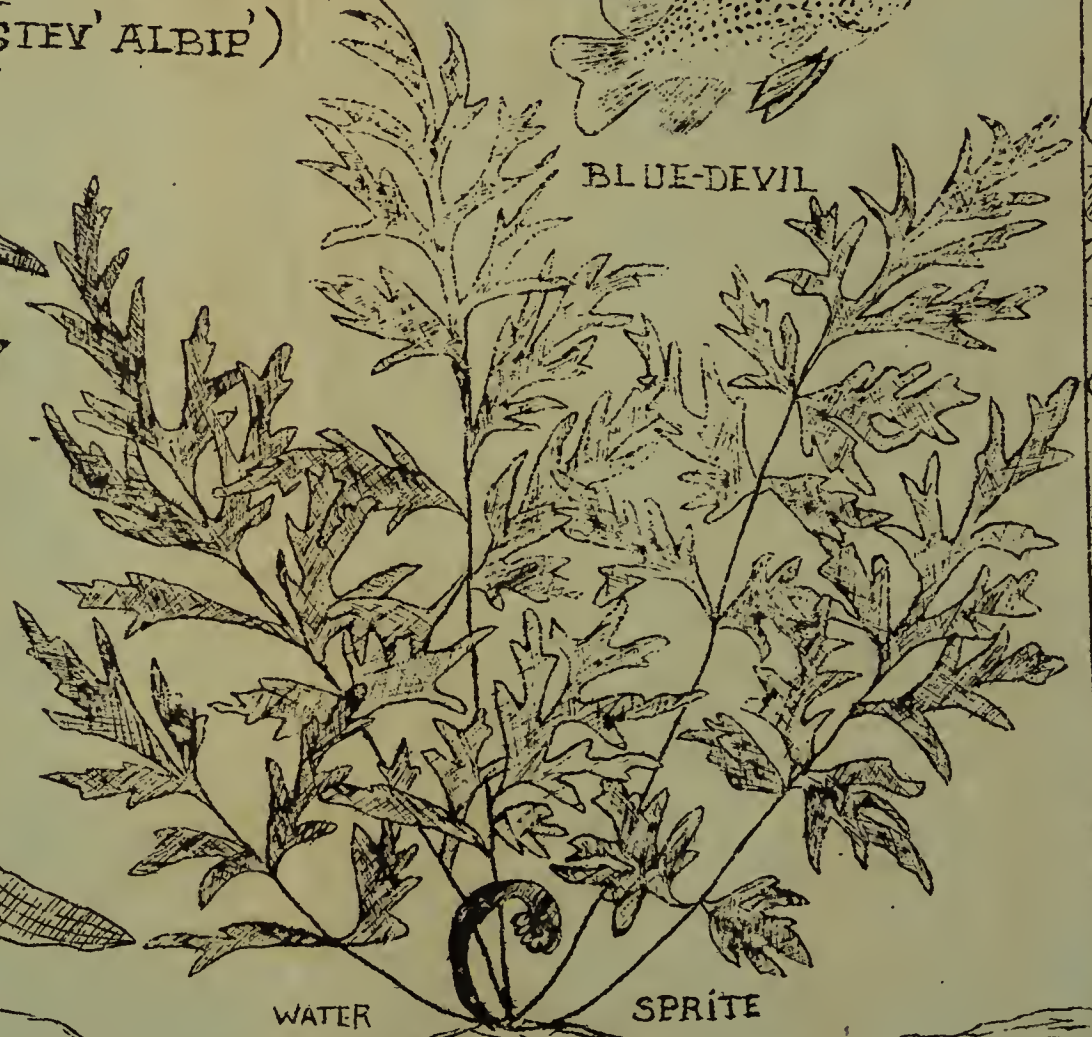

All shipments go forward in rotation (as they come in) via Express, which is the safest way to ship and the only way that we can guarantee live healthy arrival.

TERMS -

Orders go forward only when sufficient funds to cover accompany. Shipments made C. O. D. will go forward only when at least 25% of the total is sent with order to guarantee acceptance.

Our Shipping Department is endeavoring at all times to deliver to you live healthy specimens and use their best judgment as to how many fish will ship safely in a can in the Summer, or in thermodynamically packed cans in the Winter.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO HANDLE FLORIDA TROPICALS

MOLLIENISIA LATIPIPIA AND BLACK MOLLIENISIAS

These fish are large fish and naturally require more oxygen and cool aquariums. On arrival of a can of these fish, it is best to put in a good handful of salt to every twenty (20) gallons of water into which they are put. In this way, you will save all of your fish. Should you try to crowd them, you will find that they will die from many causes. Mollienisias are good feeders, but be careful and see to it that they eat everything, as they very seldom eat food that falls to the bottom. Plenty of room, cool aquarium and a salt bath once in a while is the best for these fish.

On all other Florida Fish, add about three teaspoonfuls of salt to every twenty (20) Gallons of water when transferring them from can to their new home.

This last is beneficial to all Tropicals and will not hurt Aquatic Plants.

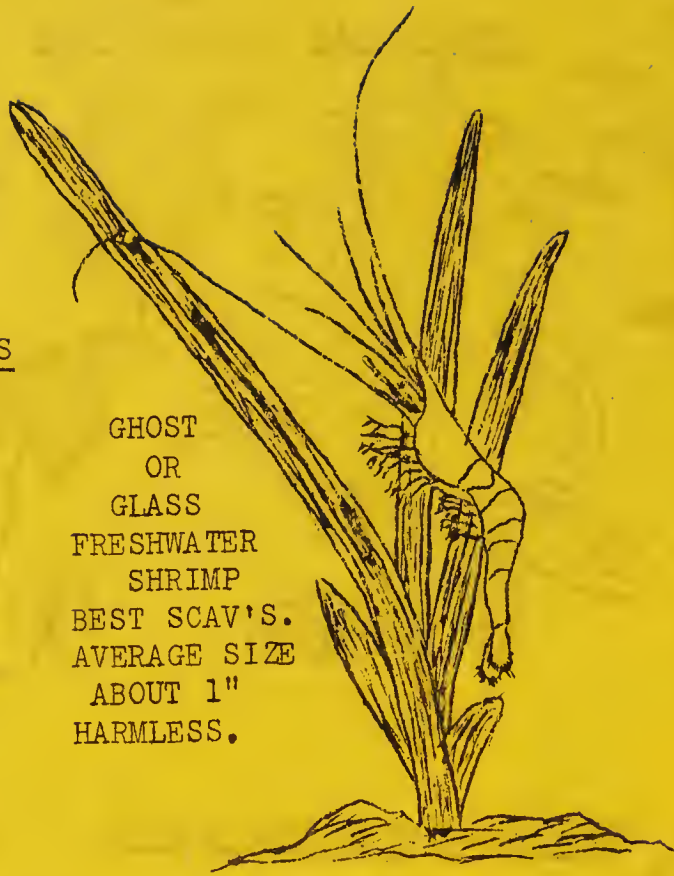

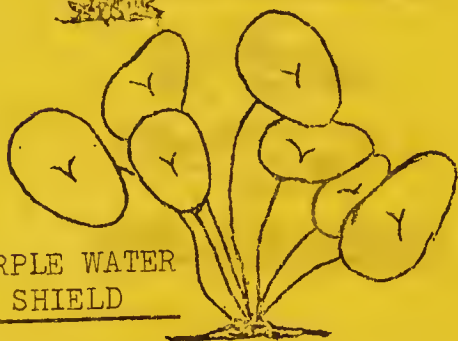

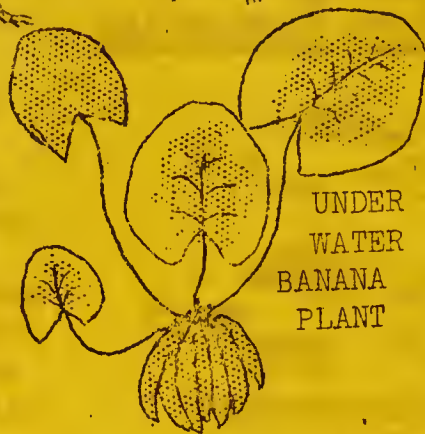

INSTRUCTIONS AND SUGGESTIONS ON THE HANDLING OF PLANTS ON ARRIVAL

ROOTED PLANTS -

On receipt of your plants, we would suggest that all rooted plants, such as Sagittarias, Vallisnerias, Spatterdocks, etc., be planted up in your aquariums, planting them so that they will show off to their best advantage. This will draw the attention of the buying customer. It is not good to let them lay around on top of the water, as this soon causes them to spoil in shape and even rot.

BUNCH PLANTS -

It is best to put these in an aquarium where there is running water and plenty of room. This keeps them in good condition for a long period of time. Of course, if you do not have a steady trade on them, it is best to separate the bunches, that is, taking the leads off which surround the bunch and plant them up in your aquariums. The plants will then take root and stay in good condition until sold.

FLOATING PLANTS -

Even though they have roots, such as Salvinia, Floating Hearts, Hyacinths, Water Lettuce, Australian Water Fern, etc., should be allowed to float.

One of the greatest causes of plant spoilage, is lack of sunlight. With a few exceptions, all Aquarium Plants require at least three to five hours of sun per day, or the equivalent in strong electric light over the aquarium. Plants not given sun usually deteriorate and spoil. This is also true of fish, as many varieties of Tropical Fish get the disease called "Rickets," because aquariums are kept in places where no sunlight reaches them. Such fish usually look caved in, having hollow stomachs and appear humped.

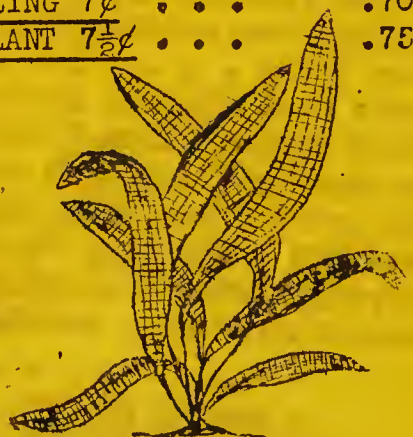
