



INSTRUCTIONS AND SUGGESTIONS ON THE HANDLING OF PLANTS ON ARRIVAL

ROOTED PLANTS -

On receipt of your plants, we would suggest that all rooted plants, such as Sagittarias, Vallisnerias, Spatterdocks, etc., be planted up in your aquariums, planting them so that they will show off to their best advantage. This will draw the attention of the buying customer. It is not good to let them lay around on top of the water, as this soon causes them to spoil in shape and even rot.

BUNCH PLANTS -

It is best to put these in an aquarium where there is running water and plenty of room. This keeps them in good condition for a long period of time. Of course, if you do not have a steady trade on them, it is best to separate the bunches, that is, taking the leads off which surround the bunch and plant them up in your aquariums, // The plants will then take root and stay in good condition until sold.

FLOATING PLANTS -

Even though they have roots, such as Salvinia, Floating Hearts, ; Hyacinths, Water Lettuce, Australian Water Fern, etc., should be allowed to float.

One of the greatest causes of plant spoilage, is lack of sunlight. With a few exceptions, all Aquarium Plants require at least three to five hours of sum per day, or the equivalent in strong electric light over the aquarium. Plants not given sun usually deteriorate and spoil. This is also true of fish, as many varieties of Tropical Fish get the disease called "Rickets," because aquariums are kept in places where no sunlight reaches them. Such fish usually look caved in, having hollow stomachs and appear humped,
