About one-third of the No. 3 liners will do for light grafting.

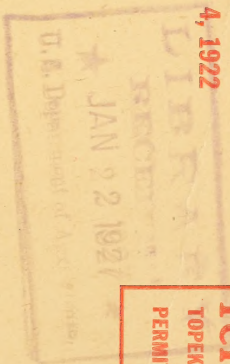

APPLE GRAFTS

The list of Grafts offered below are wrapped with waxed thread and the UNION ROLLED IN ROSIN AND PARAFFINE. This makes an AIR-TIGHT UNION, prevents fungus, keeps out the water, insures a better stand and, we think, less root knot. The expense entailed is considerable more than the ordinary way of wrapping.
