

All Bulbs Rigidly Inspected and Treated

All bulbs shipped out of or into Oregon are required to undergo rigid inspection and careful fumigation and treating. At request of Oregon Gladiolus growers quarantine regulations have been applied in this state so that Gladiolus are submitted to at least three cyanide treatments. To be safe we have given cyanide treatments to ours as required. In addi-tion all bulbs are handled under napthalene flakes and also are given special baths before planting. No pests can live in our bulbs. All go from the warehouse under a special Gladiolus inspection and are shipped under a special certificate covering Gladiolus from our state department of agriculture.

Last session we sold out in nearly all except very small sizes and therefore had only small bulbs to plant. We may be short on No. 1 bulbs in some varieties so please give second choice. Our bulbs are of fine quality this year, the finest we have grown for years. We are sure you will be satisfied. We

have a location that is ideal for growing fine bulbs.
