How to Use Rodopell

It does not kill rodents but drives them away from the plantings. It is harmless to pets and birds.

Rodopell is simple to use. It is only necessary to scatter a small amount (about one heaping tablespoonful — more is harmless) around each bulb at planting time.

For small plantings done with a trowel drop a pinch of Rodopell in the bottom of the hole; set the bulb; partially cover the bulb with soil; then scatter more Rodopell around the bulb to ring it; and cover as usual.

For large plantings where the bed is dug out, scatter Rodopell lightly over the bottom of the bed; set the bulbs in place; spread a small amount of soil to partially cover the bulbs; scatter more Rodopell around the bulbs and cover as usual.

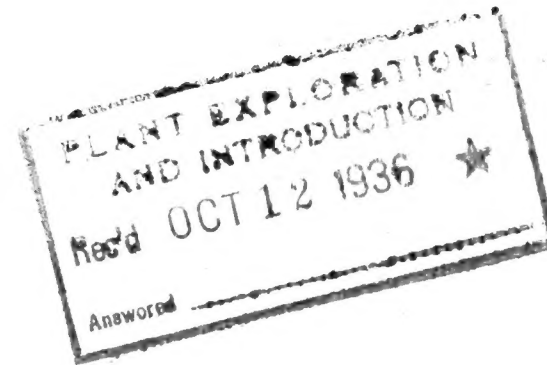
