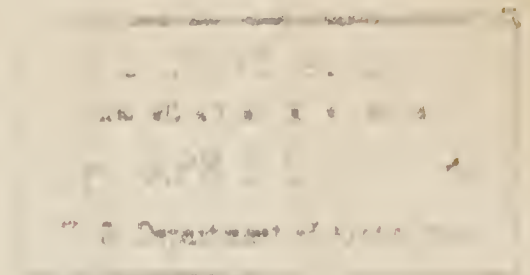

I do not have a catalog. I only have a surplus of Plum Trees and Grape Vines. I have approximately 30,000 to 40,000 Plum Trees budded on the marianna root in the following sizes and prices:

3 ft. to 4 ft.	-----	13¢
4 ft. to 5 ft.	-----	15¢
5 ft. to 6 ft.	-----	18¢
6 ft. to 7 ft.	-----	20¢

I have approximately 30,000 Grape Vines budded on the wild mustang root in the following varieties: Black Spanish, Carmen, Ellen Scott, and Edna; at \$50.00 per thousand. All prices are F.O.B. San Antonio. We can make immediate shipment.
