If you are troubled with thrip, use ROTOTOX, or formula contained in our planting instructions sent with each order, and you will get rid of them.

LARGE bulbs are 14 in. and up to 3 in. diameter, and are generally considered best for exhibition purposes, producing the best flowers on the longest spikes.

MEDIUM size bulbs, $\frac{3}{4}$ in. to $1\frac{1}{4}$ in., give a very satisfactory spike, with florets usually as large as from larger bulbs.

SMALL bulbs, over $\frac{1}{4}$ in. to $\frac{3}{4}$ in., are planted for increase rather than blooms, but if planted early, most varieties will bloom.
