

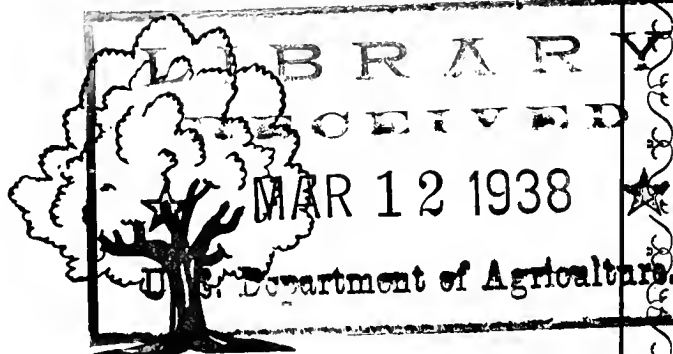

# EUONYMUS ALATUS COMPACTA
