

HARDY AZALEAS

Evergreen Varieties

Our azaleas are exceptionally bushy, heavily budded, well rounded plants which have been properly pinched back to insure full heads. Pot-grown azaleas are shipped in paper pots and during winter months all azaleas are packed in freeze-proof boxes.

When considering sizes, please do not confuse our measurements with straggly, shapeless plants which may have a large so-called spread but are not at all bushy.

FRENCH HYBRID LILACS

All our lilacs are root-grafted, planted deep, and are all on their own root. Our stock is often pruned back to insure heavy plants. Our 12-15 inch size (4-15 branches) will make excellent material to grow on in pots, for forcing purposes. Through our method of culture, suckers are practically eliminated.

LINING-OUT STOCK

All of our lining-out stock has a heavy fibrous root system, and is properly wrapped in paper, either with small balls of earth left on the roots, or in case of bare roots, with damp moss.

Our grafts are the best offered on the market. We use heavy grafts on good understocks or roots, and we ship only grafts which have calloused well and also hardened off properly, insuring the least loss when planting outdoors.

ORDERS: State size desired and give specific shipping instructions—whether by freight or express, date of delivery and to whom notice of delivery is to be sent. If no shipping instructions are included we will ship by the best carriage. If no date is specified we will ship at once or as soon as weather or condition of plants allow.

PRICES: We quote five or more plants of ONE KIND at the ten rate, 25 or more at the 100 rate. Packing at cost of material.


TERMS: To all customers unknown to us cash with order or satisfactory references. Regular accounts are due net thirty days or 2% discount within ten days. For cash in advance there is no packing charge.

GUARANTEE: We guarantee our stock to be true to name and to be of size and quality represented.

INSPECTION: All shipments are furnished with New Jersey Department of Agriculture Certificate stating that all plants growing in our nursery are free of scale, injurious insect pests, and destructive plant diseases.

TRANSPORTATION: All shipments are adequately and carefully packed; and shipped over the Central of New Jersey or Pennsylvania Railroads.

CLAIMS: If stock is unsatisfactory, claims should be made promptly upon receipt of goods.
