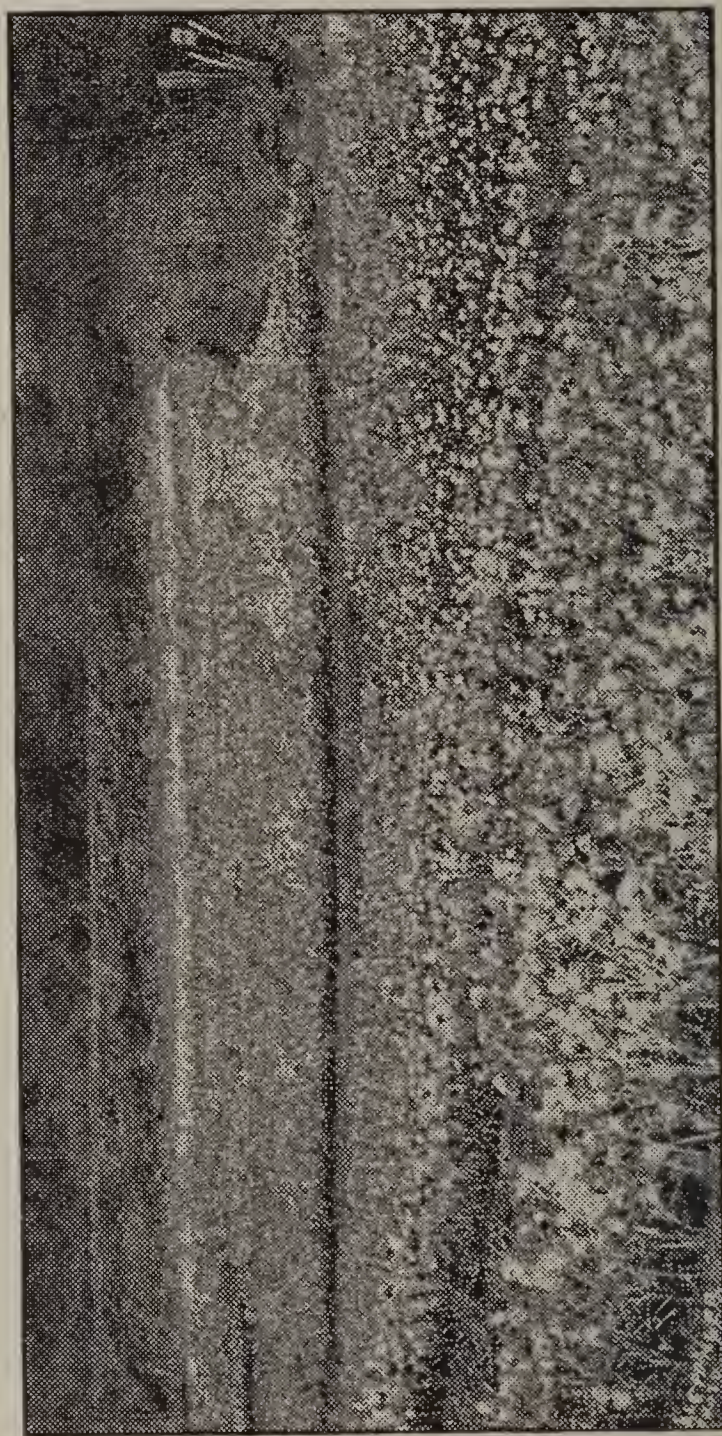

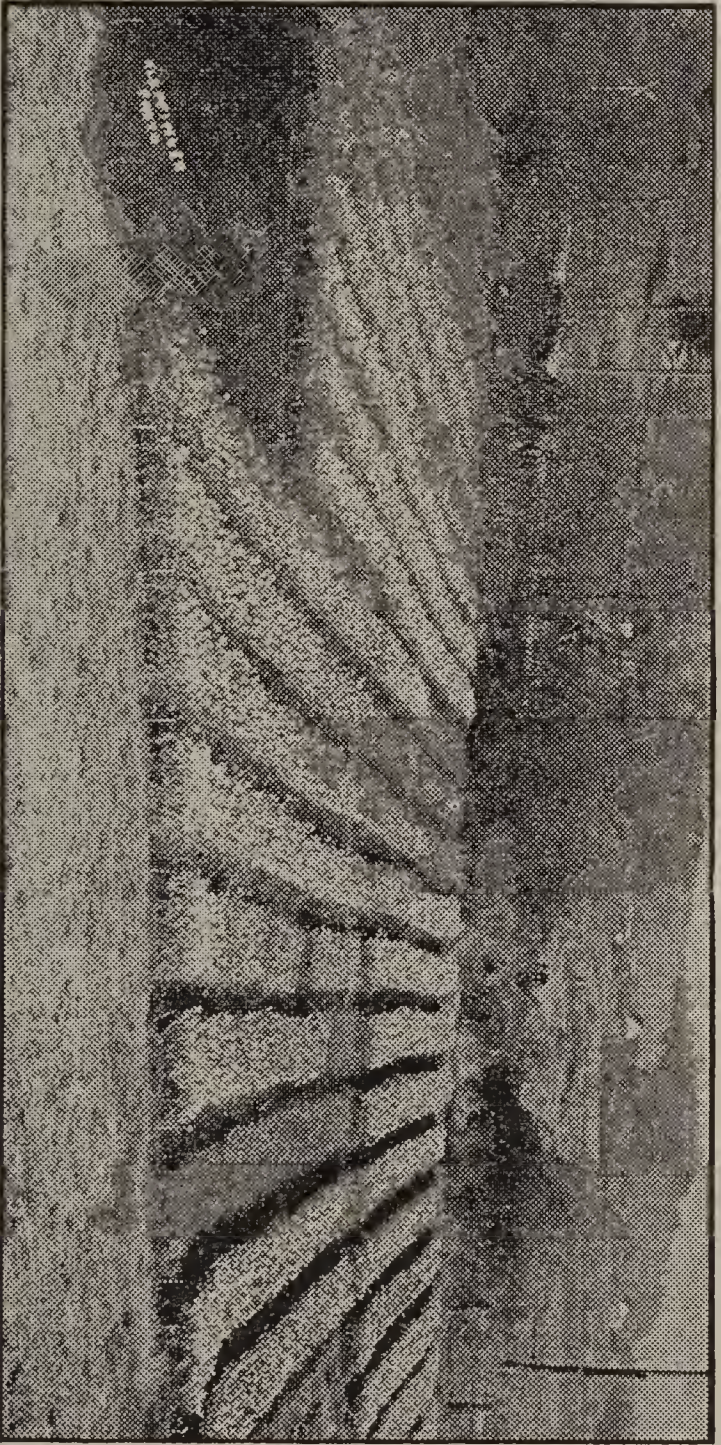

CULTURAL DIRECTIONS

PLANTING TIME

All bulbs should be planted in the autumn for spring flowering. Bulbs may be planted from September until the ground freezes; the earlier the better. Bulbs should be planted so that the roots can get started before cold weather sets in.

Anemone	2 inches deep, 6 inches apart
Crocus	2 inches deep, 4 inches apart
Narcissus	4 inches deep, 6 inches apart
Daffodils	4½ inches deep, 6 inches apart
Dutch Iris	4½ inches deep, 4 inches apart
Spanish Iris	4½ inches deep, 4 inches apart
English Iris	4½ inches deep, 6 inches apart
Tulips	4½ inches deep, 5 inches apart
Lilies	6 inches deep, 8 inches apart
Hyacinth	5 inches deep, 7 inches apart

HOW TO PLANT

In light and sandy soil bulbs should be planted a little deeper and a good supply of well rotted manure worked into the soil before the bulbs are planted will aid very materially in producing beautiful blooms.

FOR INDOOR CULTURE

For indoor planting bulbs should be potted as soon as possible and then left out in the open, covered with a few inches of soil until freezing weather, and then brought into the cellar or other sheltered place where the temperature is not over 50 degrees, but, of course, not freezing. Keep in the dark until the roots are well established and then they may be brought to the light and will flower from time to time till Easter.
