Minimum weight for freight is 100 pounds. Proportional express rates for shipments over 100 pounds; for less there is a sliding scale which will be quoted upon application.

Our No. 1 grade roses packed with moss for freight or express weigh about 70 pounds per 100. About 30,000 plants can be loaded in a refrigerator car.

FREE PACKING. We do not charge for packing, boxing and material.

EXPRESS. All stock packed light with paper in veneer boxes for express shipment unless ordered otherwise; however, this method keeps roses in the best condition.

Roses are packed with paper for small quantities.

GRADE NO. 1. This is a regular grade. Teas and Hybrid Teas, Polyanthas, about 18 inches and up; Climbers and Hybrid Perpetual, about 24 inches and up, three or more branches.

GRADE 1½. This is a lighter grade. Teas and Hybrid Teas about 12 inches and up; Climbers and Hybrid Perpetuals, about 18 inches and up, two or more branches.

CLAIMS. For any cause must be made immediately on receipt of shipment. It is mutually agreed to between the purchaser and ourselves that we shall not at any time be liable for any amount greater than the original purchase price of the stock.
