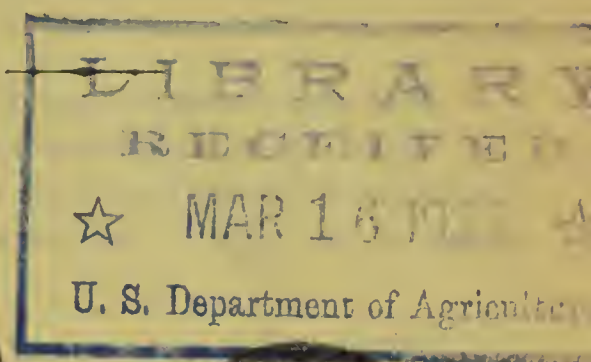

Delivery—F. O. B. Pedreckettown, N. J. Shipment as soon as stocks are ready after harvest. Bags charged for extra at cost.
