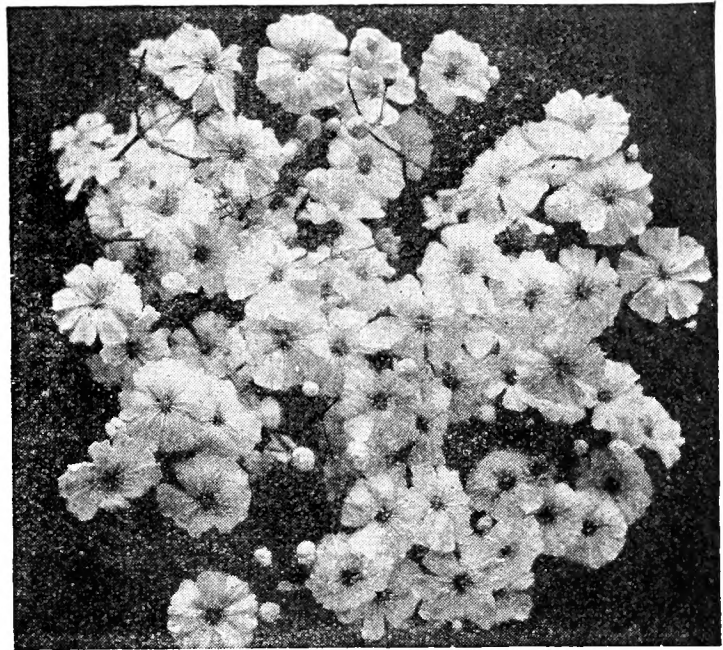
GLOXINIA HYBRIDS

Gloxinias can be easily grown from seeds, and may be started any time depending on when the flowering is desired, allowing six months from sowing to blooming. Do not firm soil in flats or pots too hard and never allow plants to become pot-bound. Use light rich soil with about a third good sharp sand, giving plenty of drainage and bring plants to bloom in five or six inch pots.

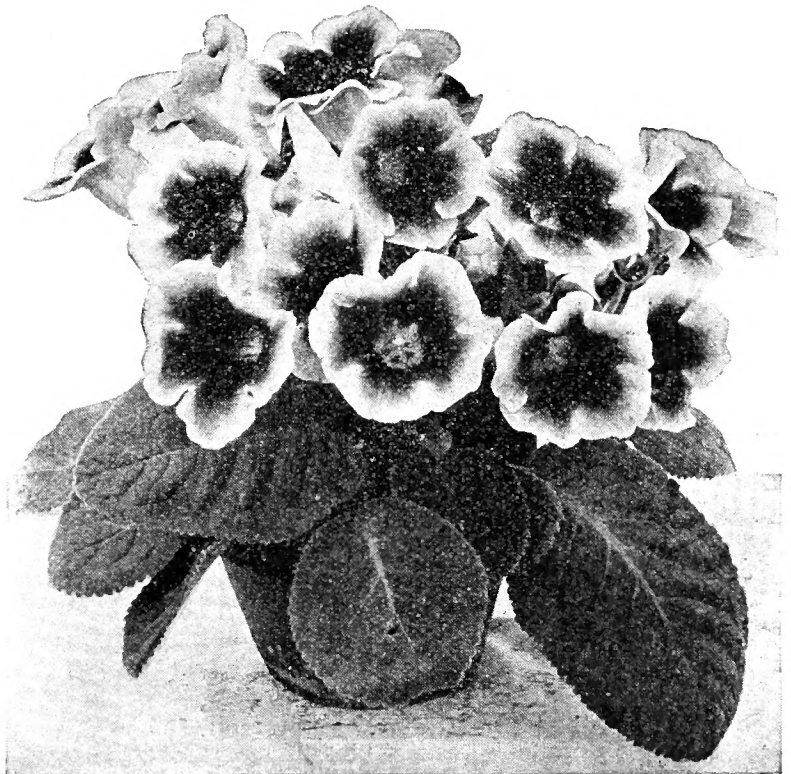

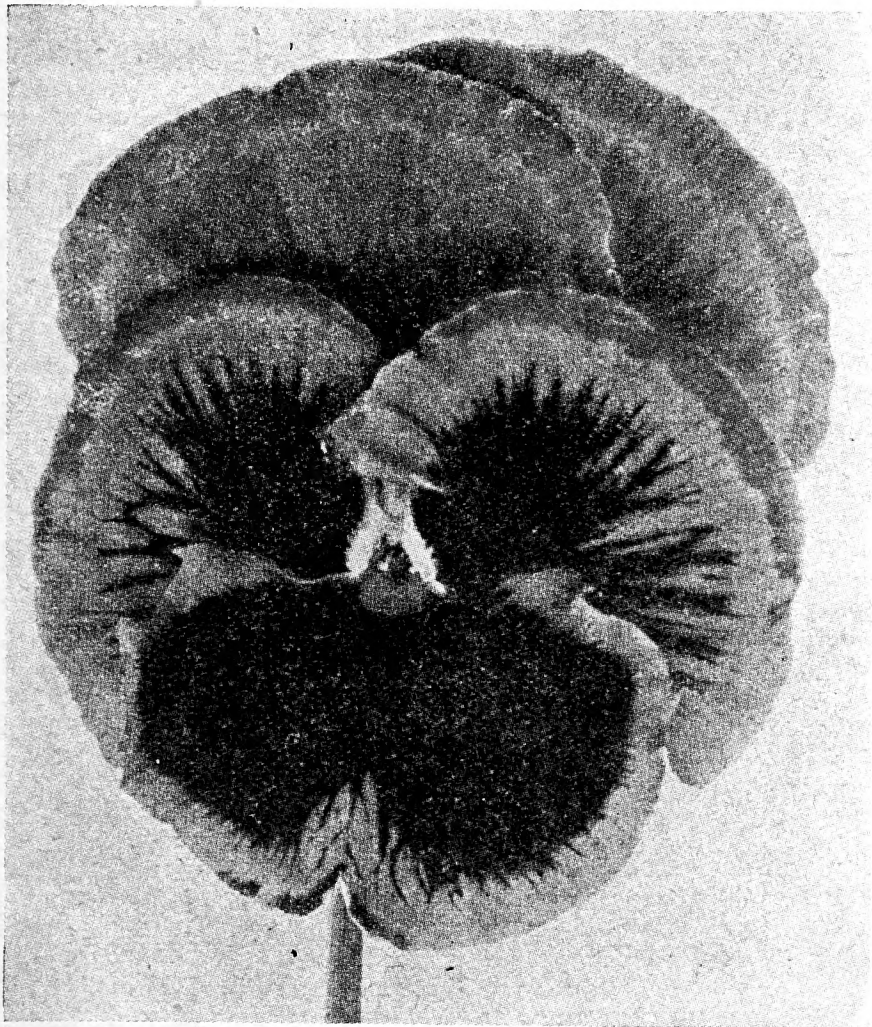

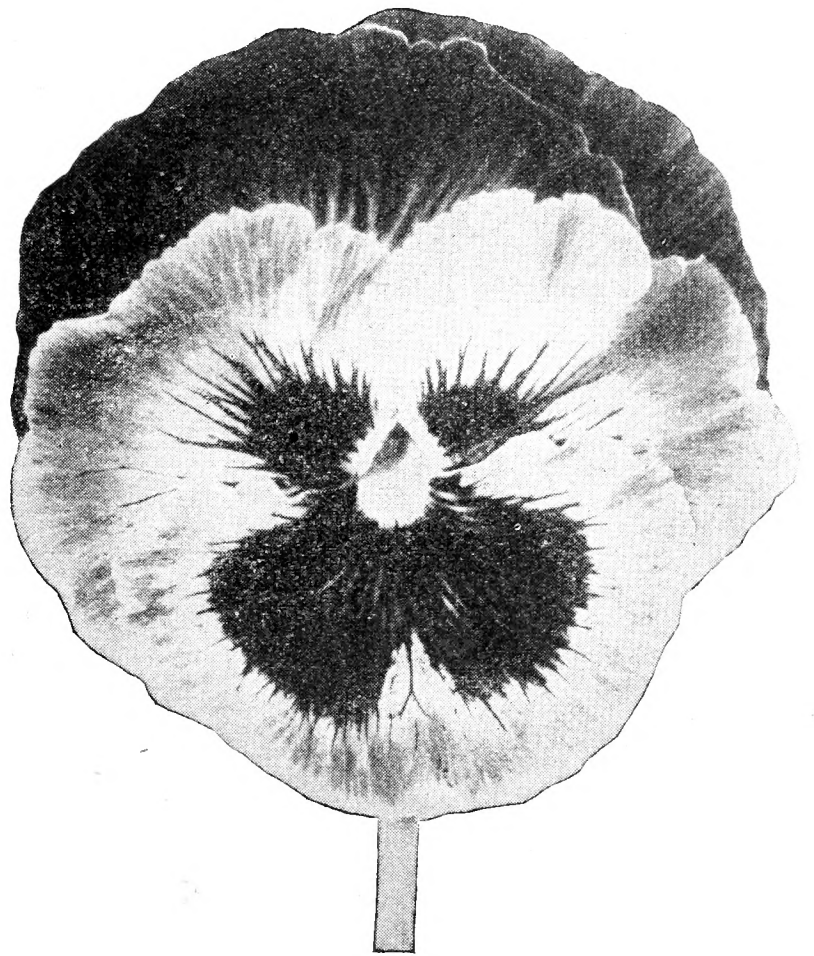
