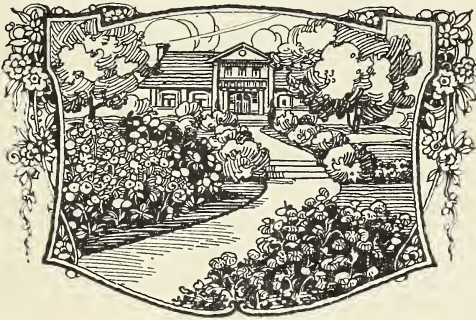

Prices in this list are strictly net cash, boxed and packed free. No charge for delivering packages to express office or railroad station. Remittances should be made by check, draft on Chicago, or by express money order or postal money order. All remittances should be made payable to LaFayette Nursery Company, West LaFayette, Indiana.

We desire to urge the great convenience of the use of your personal check in making remittance.

Five or more trees or plants may be selected at the 10 rate. Fifty or more at the hundred rate. Five hundred or more at the 1,000 rate. Strawberry, raspberry, blackberry and asparagus plants, however, are tied in bunches of 25 as they are dug in the nursery and we do not sell them in less quantities than 25, as too much time is required to break bunches and recount. Note carefully that by ordering in quantities of 50 or more you will save considerable. In order to make up the 50 you may select as many varieties as you like, say 7 apple, 11 cherry, 25 peach and 7 grape vines—different kinds of each if you wish.

We guarantee stock true to name and use the utmost care to avoid mistakes, and should any stock prove untrue to label, we will, upon proper proof, replace free of charge; but it is mutually agreed and understood between purchaser and ourselves that our liability extends no further.

Purchasers can rely upon receiving clean, healthy stock. Entomologist's Certificate of Inspection accompanies each shipment.
