TERMS—Cash or satisfactory references before shipment. To established nurserymen who are known or can give satisfactory references, 30 days from date of invoice. If paid within 10 days, 2% discount will be allowed.

FOR CASH WITH ORDER, 10% DISCOUNT

PRICES—Prices are F. O. B. Olympia, boxing and packing at cost, and are as low as is consistent with the quality of our stock.

CLAIMS—No claims for errors or discount will be allowed unless made within 10 days after receipt of goods.

Less than 50 plants at 10 rate; 50 plants of a variety at 100 rate; 500 at 1000 rate. This cancels all previous quotations.

SHIPPING SEASON—Plants can be shipped from here at any time from November to May or later, excepting at times when weather prevents digging for short periods.

CONDITION OF SALE—We give no warranty, express or implied, as to description, quality, productiveness or any other matter of any plants, nursery stock or roots we sell, and will not be in any way responsible for the crop.

There are many contingencies to be encountered in growing plants such as weather, improper care, and other conditions, over which the seller has no control, so that success is not entirely dependent upon the plants. Therefore no guarantee to grow can be given.

Our plants are grown on our own farm and given the best care and cultivation; our beds are state inspected, thus insuring your protection against disease and root wevils.

It is mutually agreed between the buyer and ourselves that we will not be liable for a greater amount than the original cost of plants or nursery stock, if at any time any should prove to be not true to name.

NOTICE—The State of Oregon has a plant quarantine prohibiting the shipping of the following plants into Western Oregon: Red or Black Raspberry, Logan, Youngberry, Blackberry or Boysenberry.

All Raspberry and Black Cap plants are free from Mosiac. Field inspection by State Inspector.
