CAULIFLOWER

Extra Early Snowball Selected

This strain is known as the standard Snowball, a splendid variety for early outdoor use, as well as forcing in frames, it is also good for fall planting. Call for my Snowball and you get the earliest, most dwarf, surest header and snow-white Cauliflower.

CABBAGE

Best Early and Second Early Cabbage with Round Heads Listed Approximately in Order of Maturity

Golden Acre (65 days)

Quite similar to the popular Copenhagen Market, but smaller and earlier. A uniform, tightly folded, and well balanced head of superb quality.

Improved Extra Early Round (70 days)

This new cabbage is very early, heads are solid, weight from 4 to 6 lbs. It is one of the earliest Round Cabbage, and will stand long after being ready to cut without splitting. Give it a trial for your first early crop.

Green Acre (New) (70 days)

This is an entirely NEW variety, very early, heads are round, stem is short. It is especially good for long distance shipping, it always has a fresh and green appearance. The heads are very solid, and will stand without splitting, it is very uniform as to size and type.

Copenhagen Late (80 days)

A quality variety with round heads averaging about 8 lbs. in weight. They are very solid and have a small core. The plants are short-stemmed, the heads being produced almost on the surface of the ground, its sturdy growth is conspicuous. The heads show no tendency to burst open, but remain fresh and firm for a long time. If the harvest is delayed, the heads will increase in weight. A most productive variety, attractive, and always tightly folded. This strain is one of the most popular Copenhagen for early Kraut Cabbage.

Glory New Strain (85 days)

A second early, sure-heading variety of large, solid heads. A compact grower allowing close planting. Especially desirable for market growers to set out in July after the early spring crops are harvested. This strain of Glory is a very heavy yielder, customers often reporting yields of 30 tons to the acre, and is one of the most popular cabbage used for Kraut making in N. Y. State.

Yellows Resistant Varieties

Early Kraut. Strain of Copenhagen Yellows Resistant (75 days)

This new, special and uniform strain of Yellows Resistant Copenhagen Kraut Cabbage produces early, large, round heads similar to GLORY. In 1939, the Geneva Experiment Station compared this strain with susceptible varieties on highly infected soil and found that this resistant strain gave a good yield while the susceptible varieties were a complete failure.

We recommend highly this strain for early Kraut.

Marion Market (77 days)

Yellows Resistant strain of Copenhagen Market. It is larger and coarser in plant, and not so early nor so uniform as Copenhagen, but with the round head and crisp tenderness of the parent cabbage.

Wisconsin All Seasons (Yellows Resistant) (100 days)

Very valuable as a substitute for the regular All Seasons in localities infested with the destructive disease known as "cabbage yellows." Chiefly used for Kraut; also valuable for winter keeping. Heads large; commonly 10—12 in. across, 8 in. deep and weigh 9—10 lbs.

WINTER CABBAGE

My Danish Selected Short Stem (95 days)

This selected strain produces a large round solid head, of extra good quality, the outer leaves having a purple tint, the small veins showing a very rich color. This is an extra fine strain, and the produce dealers' favorite cabbage. I have a private grower in Denmark, that grows only a limited amount of this seed each year. Heads are slightly flattened, ball shaped, but very hard and compact. It is very desirable for storage or KRAUT.

Wisconsin Hollander (100 days) (Yellows Resistant)

Of the Danish Ballhead type, the plants are larger, foliage is very deep green. Heads are very uniform, keeps well and makes very good KRAUT. It will produce a large yield on Yellows infected soil.

Early Red (Large) New

The heads of our Early Large Red cabbage become as solid and hard as the heads of the late varieties. It matures much earlier, and if properly stored, will keep all winter. The heads are round, very solid, the color is dark red.

We highly recommend this new strain.

Mammoth Red Rock (100 days)

This is a large yielding strain, every plant producing a good head under favorable growing conditions. It is the best late maturing RED cabbage, a good keeper.

HEADQUARTERS OF STANDARD VARIETIES OF SELECTED ONION SEED

Early Yellow Globe

Southport Yellow Globe

A great yielder, fine keeper, bulbs large globular, skin deep orange-yellow. This onion matures a little later than Yellow Globe Danvers.

Special Yellow Globe

A superior strain of Yellow Globe for late crop. It is a large size onion of excellent keeping quality, very solid with a small neck. The color is golden brown.

Yellow Globe Danvers

(Squire's Strain.) Medium early. This is an old standard Onion, very popular; earlier than Southport. Uniform in shape, good color, true to name, and of fine keeping qualities.

Southport Red Globe

The bulbs are large globe shaped, skin is thick, very deep purplish red. This strain is selected for its fine qualities, and is a good yielder.

Southport White Globe

The most popular white onion, it has a fine globe shape, skin clear white, flavor is excellent, a good keeper.

Ebenezer or Japanese

Produces excellent sets of extra fine keeping quality, which planted in the spring produce early mature onions for market. Bulbs are yellow, rather more flat than Globe, very firm and hard.

Sweet Spanish (Yellow Utah Strain)

For your garden use this strain of large sweet onions, running about 4 inches in diameter, true globe shaped, very mild, flesh is firm, and the skin deep yellow.

BEETS

Detroit Dark Red
