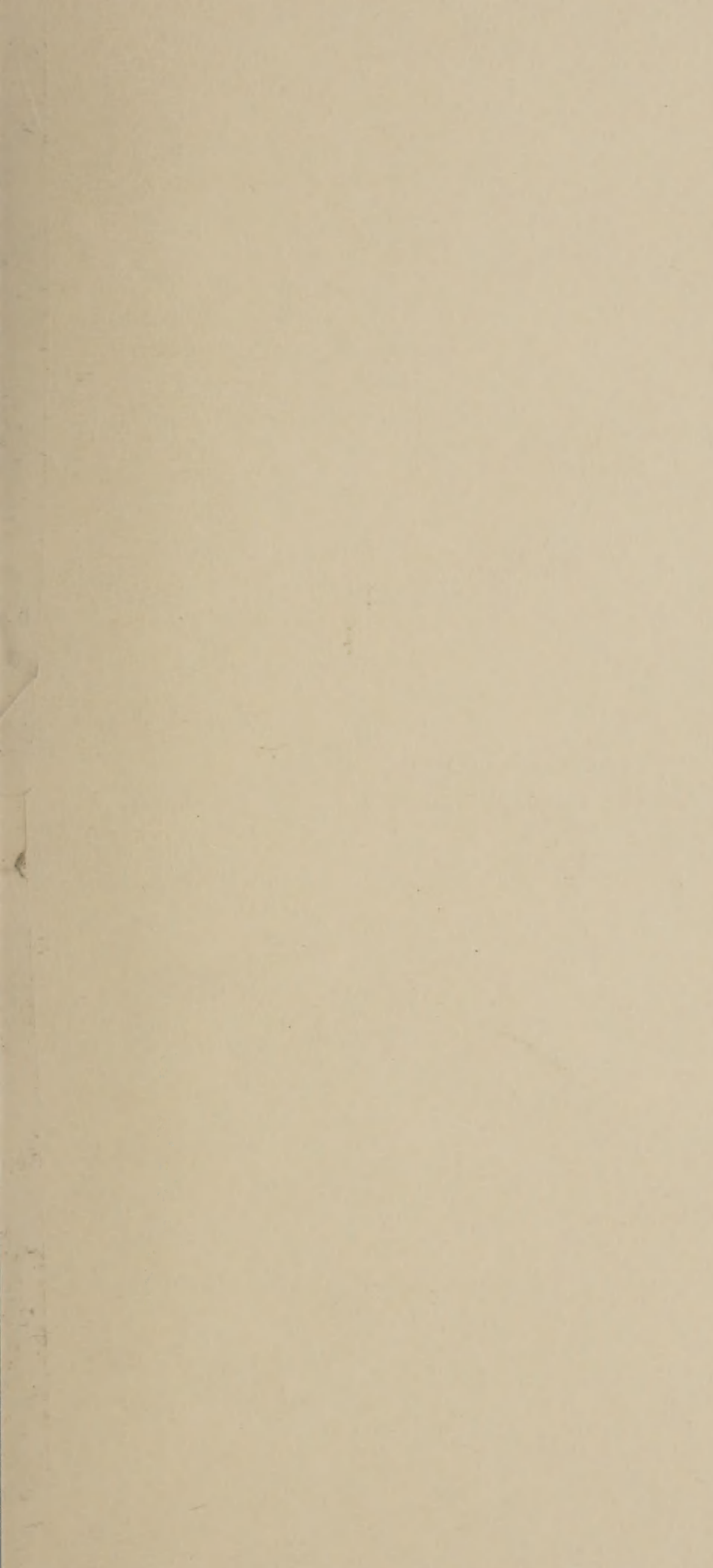

- CLARY** - SALVIA SCLAREA - THIS SEED WAS ONCE USED FOR THE TREATMENT OF DISEASES OF THE EYES
- GERMANDER** - TEUCRIUM CHAMAEDRYS - THIS MAKES NEAT EDGES FOR THE HERB GARDEN
- HOREHOUND** - MARRUBIUM VULGARE - A TEA OF THESE LEAVES IS THE BASE FOR COUGH DROPS
- HYSSOP** - HYSSOPUS OFFICINALIS - A GOOD HEDGE PLANT WITH AROMATIC LEAVES.
- LAVENDER** - LAVANDULA VERA - THIS FRAGRANT PLANT NEEDS NO EXPLANATION.
- LAVENDER COTTON** - SANTOLINA - A SILVERY LEAVED AROMATIC FOR EDGINGS.
- LOYSGE** - LEVISTICUM OFFICINALE - ALL PARTS OF THIS PLANT ARE USED IN SOUP AND SALAD
- MINT - GOLDEN APPLE** - MENTHA GENTILIS - ATTRACTIVE YELLOW STRIPE LEAVES.
- MINT - BERGAMOT** - MENTHA CITRATA - HANDSOME AROMATIC FOLIAGE.
- MINT - PENNYROYAL** - MENTHA PULEGIUM - SAID TO KEEP AWAY MOSQUITOS
