

The size of bulbs is shown by letters,  $\bf L$  meaning large bulbs 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch and up in diameter;  $\bf M$  meaning medium bulbs from  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch;  $\bf S$  meaning small bulbs from  $\frac{3}{8}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch. Blts meaning bulblets.

Where price is given as 2-10c etc. it means 2 bulbs of that size and variety for 10c.

- ALBATROSS—Large white with 6-8 blooms open on tall vigorous plant. L 2-10c; M 4-12c; S 10-15c.
- AMADOR—Popular brilliant red with 6-8 blooms open. L 2-10c; M 4-12c; S 10-15c.
- AMERICAN COMMANDER—New large red. Tall strong grower with many open. One of the best in this color. L 80c; M 40c; S 20c. Blts 10-40c.
- ANGELUS—Clear pink cream throat. Slightly ruffled.

- ANNA RAHMSTORFF—A fine dark red, long spike with 8-10 flowers open. L 2-10c; M 4-12c.

- **BARCAROLE**—Large clear orange with 6-7 ruffled blooms open. **M** 30c; **S** 20c. Blts 10-25c.
- BEACON—Bright scarlet with large cream blotch. Very showy. L 2-12c; M 3-12c; S 5-10c. Blts 25-10c.
- **BEAUTIFUL OHIO**—Beautiful new lavender. Medium sized florets. **L** 15c; **M** 10c; **S** 2-10c. Blts 20-15c.
- BEOWULF—Tall late lavender rose. Fine color. Good propagator. L 10c; M 2-10c; \$ 4-10c. Blts 20-10c.

- BLUE PEACOCK—Medium blue with light throat. L 2-10c; M 3-10c; S 6-10. Blts 20-10c.

- GOLDEN POPPY—Tall golden yellow on long wiry stems. Rich deep self color. Well liked by florists.

- ORANGE PRINCESS—Orange salmon with small crimson marking. L 2-10c; M 4-10c; S 10-15c.

- ROSA VAN LIMA—A pure clear pink. A beautiful and outstanding variety. L 15c; M 10c; S 2-10c. Blts 15-10c.
