A little domestic seed of the other varieties can be had from old plantings in this country, but not anywhere near enough to fill our needs. You will note by our prices that we have not taken advantage of that situation, but will be glad to supply the trade as long as our supply holds out.

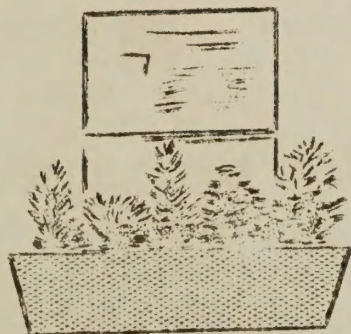
