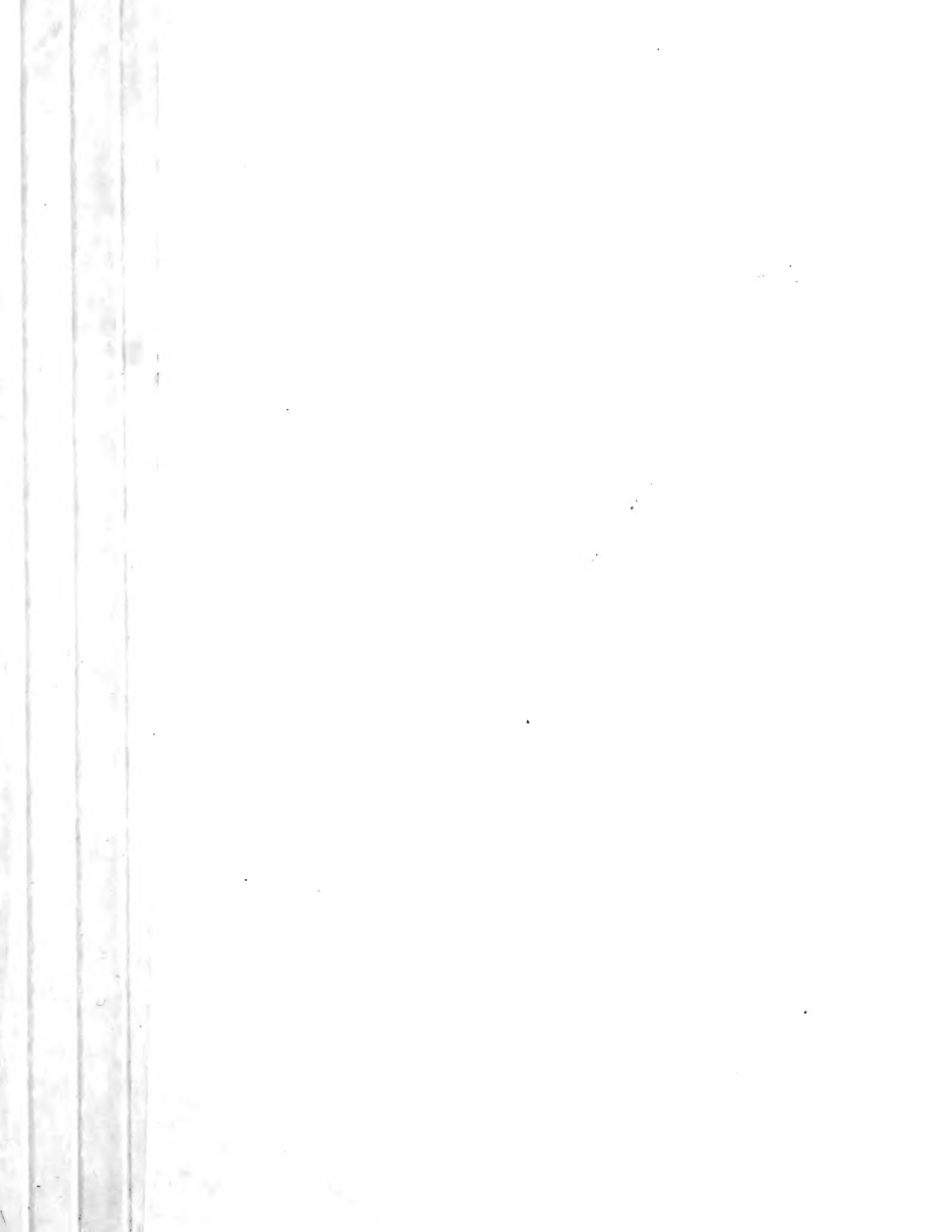

AN OUTSTANDING GLADIOLUS KING WILLIAM

Introduced 1940—Originated by Wm. Schenetsky. A constant prize winner for the past six years. A Picardy seedling, lighter in color and more vigorous and likely to replace Picardy both as a commercial and exhibition variety. King William has won over Picardy this past summer wherever shown.

Color—Soft salmon and apricot blending into a clear unmarked throat. Length 54 in.; Flower Head 26 in.; Buds 18, Open 7; Buds in color 4, Florets $5\frac{3}{4}$ in. Facing and spacing excellent. Texture very firm. Stem heavy and very straight. Foliage broad, upright and healthy.

FOREWORD

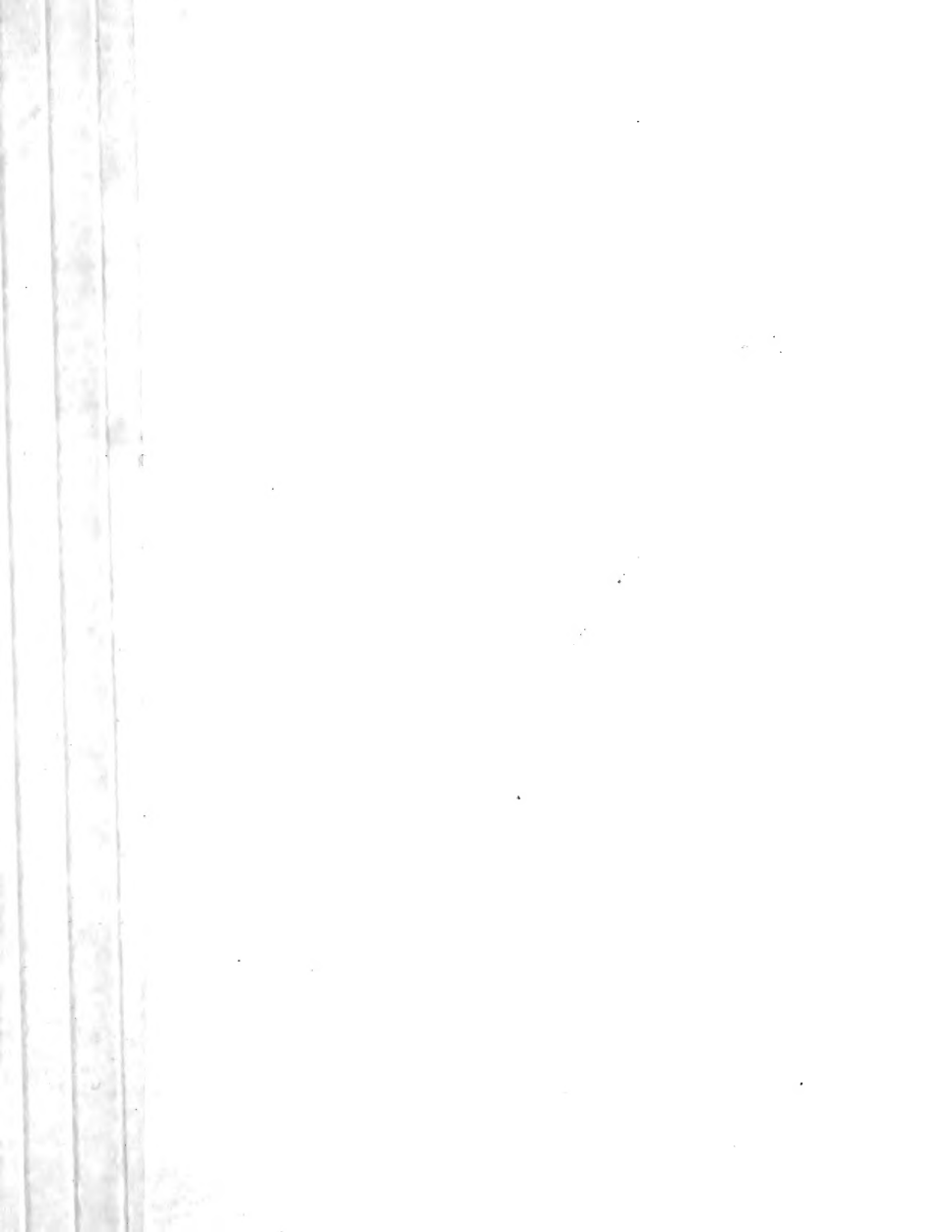

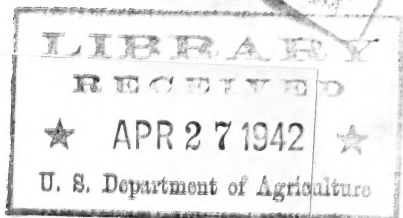
