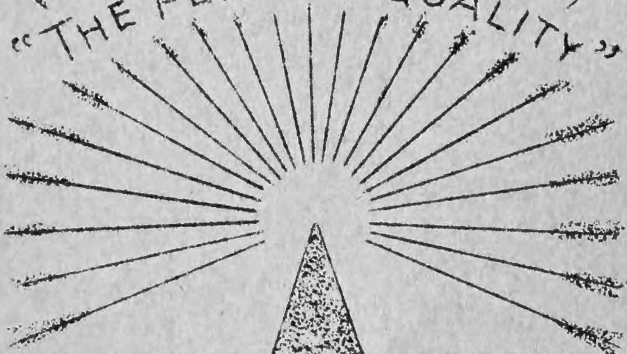

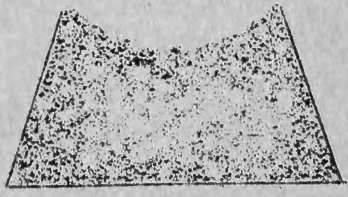

We have done our best with the color descriptions, but we cannot be sure that everyone will agree with them. It is always difficult to tell, for instance, where "deep pink" leaves off and "light red" begins. Similarly, we list no hardy variety which is absolutely white at all stages of flower development. Most of them show some pink or lilac in the early stages.

The following varieties are not hardy and should only be used for forcing or outdoor planting from Washington, D. C. south.
