THIS LIST CANCELS ALL PREVIOUS LISTS and contains all the items which we can supply at this time in wholesale quantities. You will do us a favor if you do NOT order obsolete items from older lists which can no longer be supplied.

The following assortments are specially recommended to those who wish to leave the selection of the best material available to us.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 1 - 100 plants \$3.00. Includes Cereus, Chamaecereus, Echinopsis, Eriocereus, Monvilleas, and Opuntias in 2½" pot size. 10 or more kinds of our selection.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 1A. DISCONTINUED.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 2 - 100 plants \$5.00. Contains 20 kinds of rare collectors items in a fine colorful selection of unusual Mexican and South American seedlings suitable for small pots and the better dish gardens. Globular cacti are 1" to 1½" in size and columnar types are 2½" to 3" in height. Each kind is correctly labelled. This assortment contains species listed at 60¢ per 10 plants in the following list.

CACTUS ASSORTMENT NO. 3 - 100 plants \$7.50. Contains larger plants of our selection, such as offered in Assortment No. 2, but are considerably larger in size suitable for 2½" pots.
