

Use screened sandy loam and cover seed about three times their own thickness-1-16 of an inch. If seed beds are kept moist at all times, tiny trees should appear in about thirty to fifty days. Liquid fertilizer can be added in accordance with manufacturer's directions.	We suggest using Vitamin B1 after growing starts, or when transplanting seedlings. Shading is necessary—do not place in direct sunlight. Changing temperature of house will not effect growth.	Planting Outdoors: Use frame or seed bed four feet wide and any length. Shading is necessary for at least two years. Lath shade with 1% inch openings placed 12 inches above bed. Care same as indoors, only mulching must be done during winter, with leaves, straw, humus, etc. Trees may be transplanted when they are three or four inches tall. Transplant about 4 in. apart. They require care for about 2 years after transplanting, then they can be removed to the field.
