LOCATION—We are located in Fairview Boro in the fertile garden belt, two miles from Lake Erie, and twelve miles west of Erie, in Northwestern Pennsylvania. Route U. S. 20, "The Yellowstone Trail", touches the corner of our nurseries which include 300 acres.

Fairview is the halfway mark between Cleveland, Ohio, and Buffalo, N. Y., and 60 miles east of the Nursery Center of Painesville, Ohio. It is also the closest point of contact between Pittsburgh, Pa., and Lake Erie.

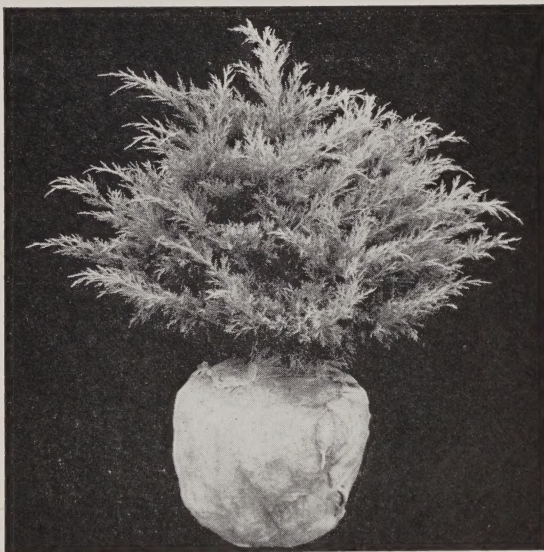

Juniper Glauca Hetzi

A spreading-type evergreen, decidedly blue, rapid in growth, and stands shearing well, making fine heavy stock.

While it is not a Chinensis, it closely resembles Pfitzeriana, but has the advantages of the blue-colored foliage and is somewhat more rapid and denser in growth. It makes up more readily as a staked spreader, is much more easily propagated by cuttings and is a more rapid grower when small.

In 31 years of full line production and heavy propagation this is the only new evergreen we have really propagated in quantity. We feel that it will be worthy of our customer's confidence, and will make a profitable item.



Policy: It is our desire to get this evergreen widely distributed throughout the trade and to serve as a source of lining-out stock for the next few years. We have priced it reasonably and will endeavor to hold this price constant until affected by outside propagation. Not to be patented.

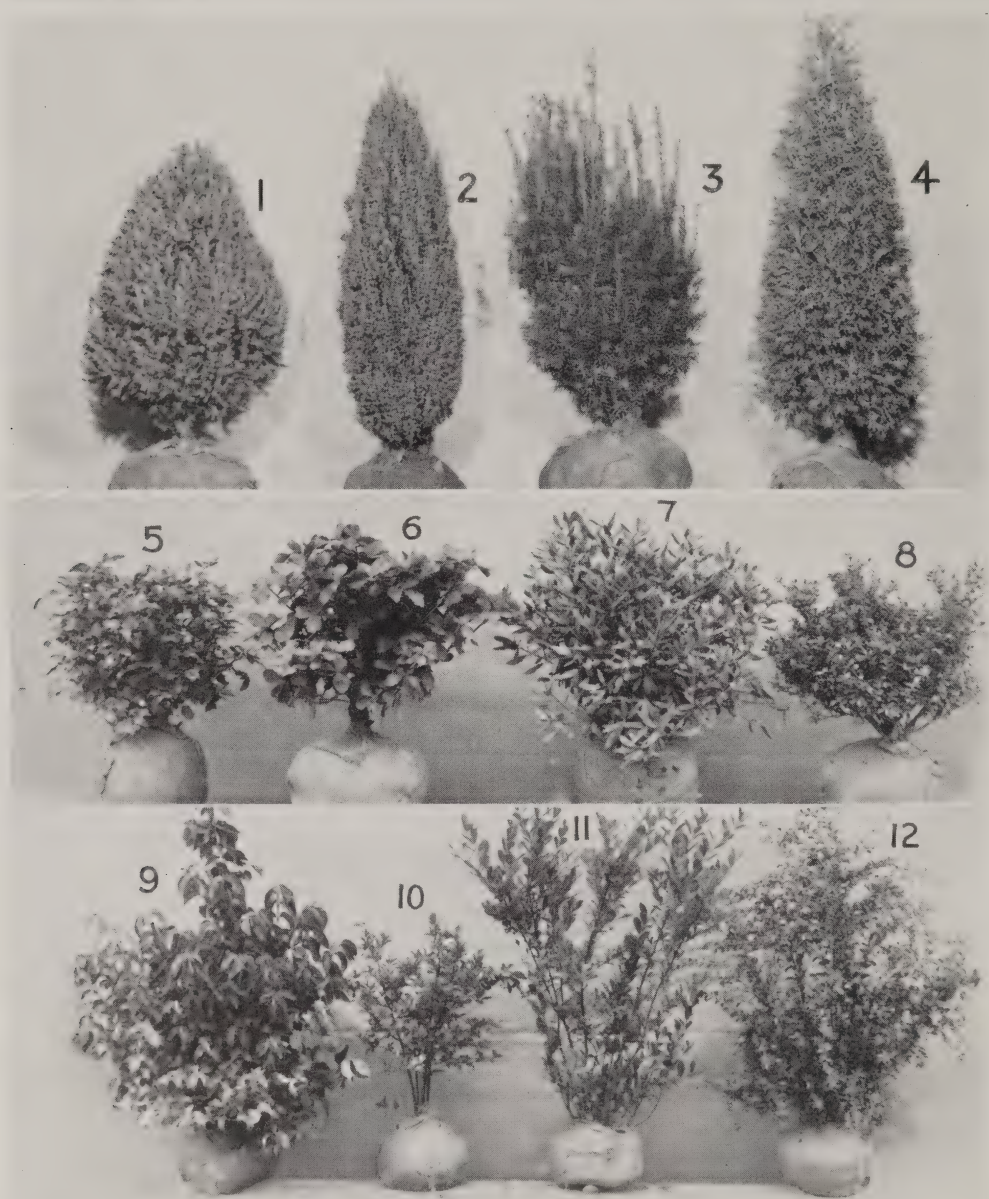

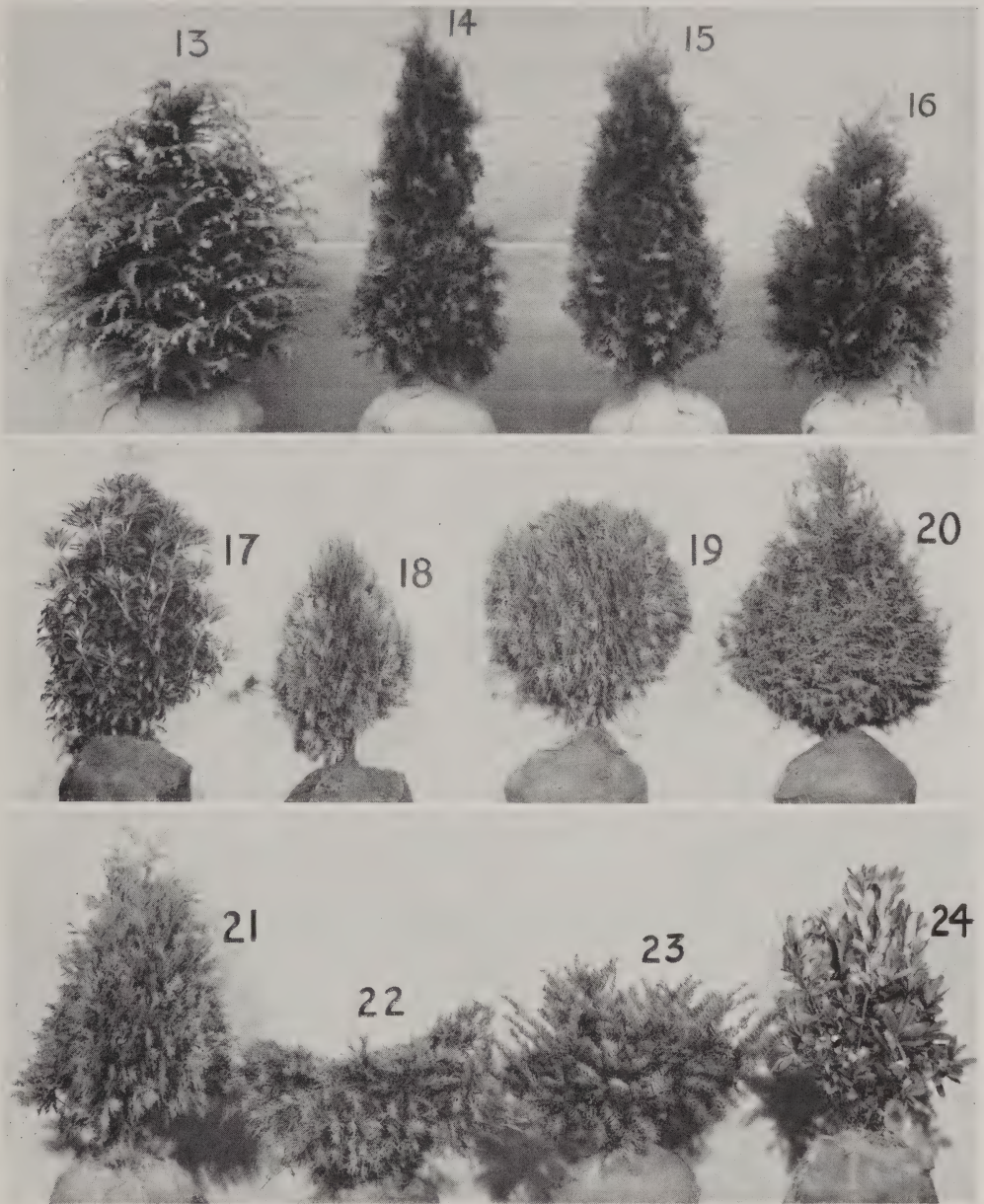
