Part I

Introduction



Going back in retrospect over this year, from Spring to Fall, we have experienced, for the growing of glads, one of the finest seasons we have ever known. The weather has been just about right. To top off this ideal condition of nature, the War is over, which, in itself, is wonderful for those who love Peace.

The Michigan Gladiolus Show came just after the war's end; so, many folks could get to Ann Arbor where this Society's show was held this year. The competition at this show was very keen; even at that, we won 63 ribbons on named varieties and seedlings, including a gold rosette for a sectional champion with Golden Goddess. We also won a first and a bronze medal on three best seedlings. (These were first-year seedlings.)

Many folks who were at the exhibit also visited our Farms, which are on highway US - 23, only seven miles north of Ann Arbor. We received many compliments on our growing methods. And since the show we have had about one hundred visitors each week-end. Most of these callers have expressed surprise at the number, size and beauty of our first-year seedlings. Some cannot believe there could be the color and size we have here until they view our fields.

For instance: yesterday I cut a clear, medium yellow of 5½ foot height. It has 24 buds and flowers. Of formed type it has six-inch florets. Today I cut a seedling from the same seed pod, with like texture, size and buddage, except this one was a light, salmon-flesh color; also, today I cut a white and orchid, one-year-seedling that was six feet tall; it had 29 buds with six-inch blossoms of fine texture. (All of the fine seedlings, such as these, are made into bowl arrangements so that our visitors may see them in the best envisionment.)

We have all types of modernistic bowls and vases in which one- and two-year-old seedlings in one-, two and three-color designs may be placed. We take Kodachrome

shots of these arrangements. There is no flower having the color range of gladiolus, that can surpass them for any modernistic design.

Again this year, we used straw between the rows, not only to hold moisture but also to keep down weeds. Under this method we were able to have named varieties up to seven feet in height. The first-year seedlings grew from three to six feet. Some of our seedlings were grown in a lath frame, which, with special feeding of trace minerals plus fertilizer, went up to seven feet; the shortest was three and one-half feet tall.

These seedlings, although shaded by lath, were never attacked by thrip. It is quite proof to us that a healthy plant from healthy soil are not susceptible to attack by insect or fungi. (Wish you could have seen the shiny, green foliage and beautiful flowers of those glads!)

We believe a healthy soil, having sufficient plant-growth elements, makes for immunity in glads against insect or fungi damage. When we speak of plant-growth elements, we mean more than nitrogen, phosphate and potash; yes, we refer to fifteen more of necessary minerals; here are a few: lime, iron, boron, zinc, silver, copper, manganese, magnesium, and molybdenum.

We would like to have a personal heart-to-heart talk with you on healthy soil. As this cannot be, we hope to have an article on soil health in the N. E. G. S. yearbook. We believe you never really will have bulb health until you have the soil in the right condition.

As an example in another plant line, we were always troubled with tomatoes having cracks in ripening and also the fruit were green around the stem. This year we planted an early variety having fruit set at planting time as a check without the needed elements; these were 18 inches high. We planted a mid-season variety about a week later; these were six inches high. They were given the added elements and, believe it or not, we had the same old trouble with the first planting; the small, mid-season variety grew vines up to seven feet; they produced three times

as much fruit as the early kind did. They were not green topped or cracked and produced tomatoes as early as those of the early variety.

This kind was Firesteel, the other Stokesdale. This last-named variety had fruit of finer flavor than Firesteel. Think it over. If plants do not get the right food elements, how will we get the right minerals in our milk, meat and vegetables? And may I add, glads? Most of our cultivated soils in this country are depleted of many mineral elements.

The gladiolus stock and our seedlings were inspected last week by the Michigan State Department of Agriculture and each bed and block were given a clean bill of health. The inspector, Mr. Beyer, said that he never saw a finer bunch of glads. And he wants some of our bulbs for his garden. Mr. Beyer hybridizes jonquils and daffodils.

We have found a new way to keep pollen in good condition for long periods of time; we use plastic florists' tubes; in the bottom is placed a layer of cotton; on this is placed the anthers containing pollen; at the top is another layer of cotton under the rubber lid. Pollen will keep in this way for from 60 to 180 days.

Nearly forgot to mention the S.E.M.G.S. show which was held at the Chrysler Building in Detroit, Michigan. For this exhibit we received 42 ribbons for named varieties. Also a gold rosette for the glad with the largest flowerhead. This spike was Black Magic, and it was extra beautiful. It came within a hair of being first-day champion. And we are still wondering why it did not make it to the top! So, for the two shows, we won 105 ribbons, two gold rosettes and a bronze medal!

We wish that the secretaries of all other glad societies, besides those of which we are members, would send us programs and entry tags. We wish to enter seedlings in every glad exhibit next summer.

As we mentioned in our last catalogue, we have a few U.S.-12, three-year seedlings with a large number of two-year-old seedlings listed in this catalogue. Now, for those who like this or that quality in a

glad, everyone could be satisfied by age, color or type by ordering two-year or three-year seedlings. You have their description now in your hands. You have the right to name and introduce them. All rights are released by us for your benefit. You get all bulbs and bulblets, so you have full control of the entire stock. After you purchase a seedling, we still guarantee it for a full year; if it does not then turn out as expected, we will give you the full purchase price in first-year seedling bulbs, IF you will return the two- or three-year-old stock and the increase. But, above all, we want each and every customer to be satisfied. Many of our customers must already be satisfied if the wonderful letters we have received are any criterion of satisfaction.

In this catalogue we are also offering two new features: First, boxes of one- and two-year seedling bulbs wrapped and ready to send as Christmas gifts to those whom you like the bulbs sent, with your card. You get extra value in these boxes as we have tagged fine two-year seedlings in the field. We had no time to write up field reports on these two-year seedlings for our catalogue; so we do not know color, type, size, etc.—only the parentage will be given with each seedling; some are worth up to \$300.00.

Next, we have a grab-bag of two-year seedlings that will be picked out of the blank tag group and only the parentage will be given. These will also be worth from \$5.00 to \$300.00 each. Not more than three grab-bags will be sold to one customer, as long as stock holds out. All the above is subject to prior sale.

As we have taken up so much space here, we will give nothing on care of bulbs until our next catalogue which will be out some time in December.

Remember, order early because this is your best guarantee that you will receive your seedling bulbs.

I nearly forgot to mention that we have listed a few bulbs at retail and a million at wholesale—of named varieties.

We hope that you have had a fine glad season and that you will visit our farms next season.

You have the right to name and disseminate any seedling purchased as you get the complete stock. We release all rights on seedlings we sell. These bulbs represent the cream of 30,000 seedlings and should be winners on the show table as well as good commercials.



Bulb Sizes

Two-year-old seedling bulbs come from one bulb which was planted this spring; and so may be any size from a Number 4 to a jumbo and some will carry up to 150 bulblets. You get all when you buy for one price.



Three-year-old bulbs may have one or two large bulbs in sizes Number 4 to jumbo, with from ten small bulbs to over one hundred; and anywhere from fifty to over one thousand bulblets. You get all for the one price!



Amt. of Order

No order for less than \$2.50 accepted.



Extras

We give extras of seedling bulbs which we feel are extra good crosses. These come from stock we do not list (because we have so few) and crosses that are very difficult to make, so you get something very fine.



Terms of Sale

Cash with all orders sent in.



Two- and three-year-old seedlings we guarantee as to the description we give;

but if these do not turn out to be as the description given, we will make purchase price good, by replacing (if stock is sent back) by one-year-old seedling stock. This guarantee is good only for one year after purchase.



Shipments

Shipments will be made either by mail or express, depending on the value of the stock, and the time it is wanted. Best shipping months are November and March.



Orders

All orders for bulbs are subject to prior sale, so order as soon as possible. Please name a second choice if that is acceptable.



Bulb Treatment

All bulbs listed were gassed with Methyl-Bromide and treated with New Improved Ceresan before planting, and will be gassed with Methyl-Bromide at digging time. Bulbs grown on sandy-loam soil.



US-12 Three-year-old Seedling Bulbs

No parentage will be given for this group. All figures are only approximate—on the number of bulbs, bulblets and the days to bloom. They may be more or less.

The following glad bulbs happened to flower in an extreme hot spell and the judging of them is according to rules of the N. E. G. S. Also the symbols of color class is that of Fischer N. E. G. S. Color Chart. Other colors mentioned are those of our own view.

The price on each of those listed includes the complete stock . . . large bulb, small bulbs and all the bulblets. These glads are the cream of our thousands of hand-crossed hybrids. Any of these are bound to make a first-class commercial.

Each of these seedlings can be seen in the Kodachrome films which we will be glad to send you with a small projector on your request, if it is first in line for a certain seedling. Send in order as soon as possible. For all projectors a deposit must be made of \$5.00, plus \$1.00 for each film desired. And we would like them to be returned within one week.

A field report was made on each seedling here listed and only fine ones are listed from these reports. Only those having good color, firm floret attachment, good floret facing, fine straight as well as gently-tapering flowerhead, right placement and fine-textured florets, stems straight and of good strength, upright, healthy foliage and excellent bulb and bulblets are offered here.

All the above requisites are under guarantee on these two-year-old seedlings; and if one does not turn out as stated, we will give you one-year-old seedlings for the return of the stock and increase, within one year.

Gentlemen:

We could make this a long story if we told you the fine results in detail which we had from the 347 Seedling Bulbs which we purchased from you last fall. To make it short, we raised 175 named varieties of gladiolus this year and can honestly say

that most of the Seedling Bulbs which have bloomed so far (nearly 200 of them) were of a much deeper and clearer color than all but two or three of the named varieties.

We had many that were five inches and six inches in size and the most beautiful that we have ever seen. We displayed most of them in our store window, putting a seedling sign on them, and believe it or not, people came in and wanted to order bulbs of lots of them. Of course, no soap, we told them, maybe sometime.

I would like very much to give you explanations of some of them but know you are very busy, so will call that sufficient for now. By the way, nine out of ten of the people who saw our seedlings didn't even know glads could be raised from seed, what a shame!

We are enclosing an immediate order and hope to be able to place another order later on. Do you have any special crosses of yellows X blues or blues X yellows?

We would like to have the order enclosed sent as soon after harvest as possible.

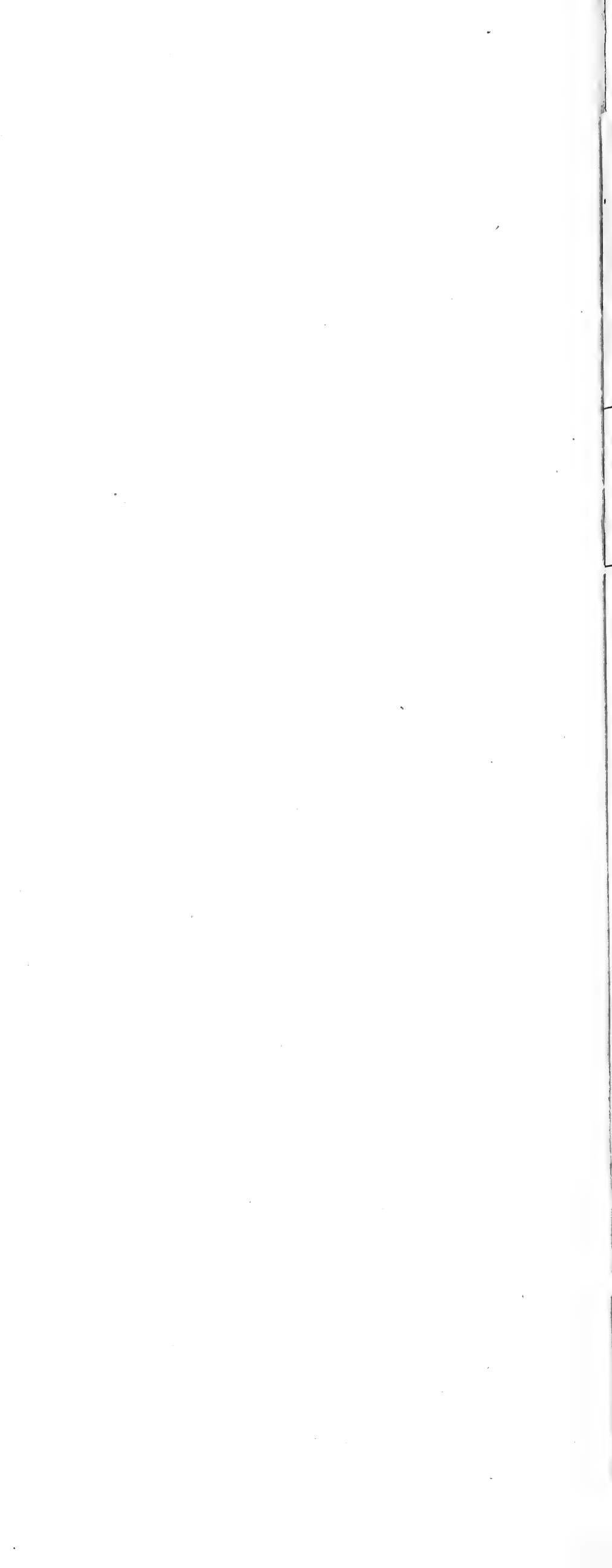
