Color: Peach-Red with edge and tips of center rows of petals Orange-Rufous. Outer rows Strawberry Pink, streaked with Maize Yellow. Few curled backs show a trace of Rose color. Flowering habit prolific. Stem 3 to 10 inches, heavy to medium flower on side. Size of flowers:  $7\frac{1}{2}$  to 10 inches, depth 3-5 to  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, heighth 4 feet  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

Have a few single tubers to realease to retail trade at \$10.00 per tuber. No Clumps.
