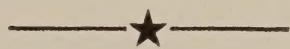
TULIPS

Fall planting bulbs of all descriptions will be extremely scarce this year, and we therefore urge everyone to place their order early, to avoid disappointment.

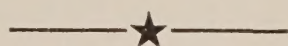
The numbers after the name of the tulip designates the approximate height of that variety at blooming time. The letters following the height indicate as follows:

For an oval bed add length and breadth and divide by two. For example a 10 x 6 ft. oval bed requires as many plants as a round bed 8 ft. in diameter.
