PLANT THE COTTON THE MILLS PREFER

- PLANT TYPE—Medium vigorous spreading and prolific.
- BOLL SIZE—Large, 60 to 70 per pound of seed cotton.
- MATURITY—Early, one of the few early maturing big boll cottons.
- PICKING QUALITIES—Excellent. Large fluffy bolls, open well.
Has high percentage of five lock bolls.
- STAPLE LENGTH—Valley Lands 1-3/32 to 1-5/32 inch.
High Lands—1-1/32 to 1-1/8 inch.
- LINT PERCENTAGE—Valley Lands—34 to 36%.
High Lands—35 to 38%.
- LINT CHARACTER—Fine fibre, very strong, hard and uniform.
- FOLIAGE—Medium Light.
- STORM PROOFNESS—Good.

Our records over a period of six years indicate that the Stoneville 2-C has at least one staple better length than the Stoneville 2-B, under similar soil and climatic conditions. In all other characteristics it is very similar to 2-B.

Official spinning and fiber tests indicate that it will be highly acceptable to all mills. It has been selected because of its good manufacturing quality and low percentage of mill waste. We believe it will be a worthy mate to the Stoneville 2-B, which is a very high recommendation for it.
