STANDARD DAHLIAS OF MERIT

ANDRIES ORANGE—Miniature

An ideal cut flower and very free blooming. The color is bright orange blending very well with fall colors. Good healthy stock and long stems. Semi-cactus..... .18

AVALON—Informal Decorative

Clear canary yellow of cut flower size. We cut four to six-foot stems last season which held the bloom erect. Late in the season it is a wonderful dahlia..... .14

BEAUTIFUL LADY—Formal Decorative

Bright lemon yellow. 8-10 inch blooms, good stems, bush 5-6 feet tall. Rugged grower, insect resistant foliage, profuse and early. A good root maker and they keep well. Scored 84 at East Lansing. On Pacific Honor Roll..... 1.25

BI-COLOR—Informal Decorative

Bloom of variegated colors with lavender predominating18

CALIFORNIA IDOL—Informal Dec.

A clear bright, glistening yellow, of immense size, and a prize-winner from coast to coast. Grows naturally to great size and has everything a great dahlia should have. We recommend it highly..... .65

CARL G. DAHL—Informal Decorative

The average bloom is about 10 inches across with many 12 inch blooms. Good long stems. Blooms are apricot and buff colors45

CAVALCADE—Formal Decorative

The color is an attractive, rich deep rose, with tones of rosy magenta. Formation and plant growth very similar to that of Jersey's Beauty, but flower is larger..... .28

CHIEF KOKOMO—Miniature

This beautiful cut flower should be listed as a small formal decorative. It has very long stems and the color is dark lavender. It does not fade out as many lavenders but holds true throughout the season. We recommend it to all our customers..... .30

CITY OF CLEVELAND—Informal Decorative

Large, orange suffused red. Thick, heavy blooms35

The brightest red dahlia of unusual large size. Plants are 5½ ft. tall and very robust..... .40

Bi-color, grayish white background with rich royal purple dots and splashes.

- JERSEYS BEAUTY—Formal Decorative**
A perfect bloom of erosion pink. The best pink dahlia to date..... .16
- KATIE K.—Informal Decorative**
Bloom 11x6, bush 5½ feet. Color is a deep rose pink, with white veins in the petal that lighten the flower considerably. Scored a certificate of merit at both Storr's and East Lansing. Is on all the 1938 Honor Rolls22
- KENTUCKY SPORTSMAN—Informal Dec.**
Bloom 10x5. Bush 4 feet. This seems the most popular of exhibition bi-colors. The color is quite unlike anything else. Yellow at center, outer petals golden amber, with rosy reverse, each petal tipped white. It blooms early and freely, and is without doubt the most beautiful bi-color..... .50
- KING OF BLACKS—Formal Decorative**
A very dark red, almost black. Early and free blooming22
- LEAH PEARL—Formal Decorative**
White and pink bloom, almost of ball type, looks like a wax dahlia. It will be in our gardens for many years..... .65
- MAFFIE—Semi-Cactus**
Bloom 12x6, bush 6 ft. Intense carmine of stupendous size. Bush growth is very rugged and foliage exceptionally heavy.... 1.25
- MARKET JEWELL—Cactus**
A small, velvety red free blooming dahlia. Very attractive28

MONMOUTH CHAMPION—Formal Dec.

A strong, vigorous grower, producing beautiful exhibition blooms of a brilliant orange flame color..... .32

MORNING MIST—Pompon

An excellent cut flower dahlia surpassing nearly all pompon dahlias in color, form, and productiveness. Beautiful white, tipped a delicate lavender..... .15

MRS. ALBIN—Formal Decorative

A florist variety. Bloom 7x4. Color is clear yellow. We highly recommend this dahlia for cutting. Blooms fairly early and continues till frost. Stems long and strong, bushes very healthy and free branching. Very good18

MRS. C. E. WILDON—Formal Dec.

Color, brilliant scarlet with orange buff reverse; blooms 9 to 11 inches on long cane-like stems; foliage heavy and leathery40

NEGUS—Formal Decorative

Oxblood red to almost black in center. Plants extremely robust, long stems, insect resisting. Try it on our recommendation. Good size blooms, held erect..... .35

PEACE—Informal Decorative

Pure white, 12 inches, blooms very early. Good where seasons are short, where many dahlias never bloom. 5 ft. high and free blooming35

PINK GIANT—Informal Decorative

Tyrian Pink. This brightest of pink shades has long been lacking in a good dahlia. Now we have it. Bloom 9x4, bush 5 feet. Pink Giant is a grand garden dahlia with big, strong, upright bushes, fine stems and plenty of bloom. Early..... .18

PREMIERS WINSOME—Informal Decorative

QUEEN CITY—Formal Decorative

Scarlet pink commercial dahlia. Very early. If you do not grow it, you are passing up one of the best..... .22

R. A. BROOMFIELD—Informal Decorative

Saffron orange flushed with rose. A large long stem dahlia which holds up good as a cut flower. Very early and free dahlia.... .22

RED JERSEY BEAUTY—Informal Decorative

A nice red dahlia the size and shape of Jersey Beauty. Used generally for cut flowers24

1942 introduction. Beautiful large bright red. Robust plant 5 to 6 feet high, long cane-like stems, large leaves and makes large round bulbs..... .40

RED SAILS—Formal Decorative

Large red with 3 ft. stems. Very attractive. We guarantee it to be good in all ways. We have grown it for 5 years and find it better than most of the dahlias introduced at \$10.00 or more..... 1.00

ROBERT EMMETT—Informal Decorative

Carmin to cardinal red40

ROSE FALLON—Formal Decorative

Very fine flower of pleasing shades of amber, russet and salmon35

ROYAL CITY—Formal Decorative

Bloom 6x4. Bush 4½ ft. Beautiful violet rose. This is a color sport of "Queen City." The plant growth, blooming habits, stems, etc., are identical to "Queen City." A fine addition to any garden..... .40

RUFFLES—Informal Decorative

Long stemmed dahlia, 10-inch bloom (larger when disbudded). Beautiful shell pink with ruffles on both sides of petals. It won the Ohio Valley Dahlia Gold Achievement Medal at Cincinnati, Ohio, for a new achievement in dahlias of the large type requiring blooms 8 inches or larger—natural stems 18 inches or more. Plants are sturdy—4-5 feet tall. We never stake them. Large clumps. We have grown them from bulbs (no cuttings) for the last four years..... 1.25

SANHICANS BLUE BIRD—Inf. Decorative
The bloom is large and of a near blue color; plants are tall with good stems..... .25

S. V. GLITTER—Pompon
