ONIONS

Southport Yellow Globe Oz \$.15	The most largely grown yellow onion. Flesh white, crisp and mild in flavor.
Southport White Globe15	An exceedingly mild onion with pure white delicate skin.
Yellow Globe Danvers15	Early, bulb rather spherical, short top. Outer reddish brown skin. Long keeping sort.
Prizetaker15	A good keeper. Flesh pure white.
Southport Red Globe15	The best variety of Red Onions.
White Portugal15	A large flat onion of mild and pleasant flavor. Used as a pickler and for bunching.
Red Wethersfield15	One of the oldest and best known types of onion. Very productive.

Moss Curled10	Very compact, densely curled and crumpled. Leaves dark green, giving a moss like appearance.

Early Alaska Lb. \$.25	Very early. Pods straight. Seed of good green color.
First and Best. American Wonder25	Good early, standard sort. Pods straight, small square ended, dark green.
Gradus25	A standard early sort, large podded variety.
Little Marvel25	Early sort. Pods large. Heavy cropper.
Laxtonian25	A large podded, dwarf variety on the order of Gradus, although more dwarf and a little earlier.
Thomas Laxton25	Fine first early sort. Very prolific.
Little Gem25	Height 2 feet. Fine quality. Productive.
Nott's Excelsior25	An extra early, standard pea. Productive and high quality.
Telephone25	An old standard main crop sort of high quality. Pods long light green, containing 8 pale green peas.
Bliss Everbearing25	An old standard, main crop variety. Height 3 feet. Matures, following telephone. Pods in pairs, medium green, 3 in. long, containing 4 to 5 green peas of good quality.
Champion of England25	Height 5 feet. Tall, late sort. Pods rather small medium green, often in pairs, straight, blunt ended. Productive.

Bell or Bull Nose \$.25	Early sort of bright red color. Fruits blunt ended, almost square, ridged, flesh sweet.

Ruby King25	A very popular variety. Fruits thick, slightly tapering.
Red Cayenne (Long)25	Bright scarlet fruits, 3 inches long, slightly curved. Long, slender shape.

Kentucky Field10	One of the best canning sorts. Flesh yellow, Very deep

RADISH

French Breakfast10	Good early sort. Root cylindrical. Skin smooth, pink, with small white tip.
Icicle10	The earliest of the long white sorts. Roots pure white. Flesh compact, of fine quality.
Crimson Giant10	Large, but not pithy. One of the best for outdoors culture.
Scarlet Globe10	One of the earliest forcing radishes. Roots of medium size.
Early Scarlet Turnip10	Early, round, deep scarlet, crisp and tender.
Scarlet Turnip White Tipped10	Early spherical sort, three quarters rose, one quarter white. Quick grower. Crisp
Long Scarlet Short Top10	Root about six inches long and of scarlet color. Top short. Good quality.
White Strasburg10	Root half long, medium early, pointed 4-5 inches long. Flesh white, pungent.

Sandwich Island15	An improvement of the ordinary type. Root thicker and shorter.

SPINACH

Bloomsdale Savoy10	Very early sort, round seeded; one of the best for market, with broad glossy, dark green leaves, crumpled.
Thick Leafed10	A strong, upright growing medium early sort.
Victoria10	Late, round seeded variety. Leaves dark green broad, thick, round. Slow to run to seed, best for market.
New Zealand10	Plant different from Spinach but is used in place of Spinach in dry soils. Leaves thick.
Long Standing10	Late, slow growing sort, round seeded. Leaves numerous, crinkled, deep green. Excellent variety for spring use.

TOMATO

Ponderosa40	A large, purple, fruited tomato, and for home use one of the best. Fruit large, few seeds.
Bonny Best20	About a week earlier than Chalk's Early Jewell. Fruit smaller, very smooth, solid and uniform. Color bright red.
Earliana20	The earliest and best of the very early tomatoes, very productive for an early sort; fruit of fair size, round very smooth and solid. Color bright scarlet.
Stone20	A favorite with Canners and Truckers. Always dependable. Deep red in color. Fruit large, smooth and solid.
Greater Baltimore20	A main crop, very productive, red fruited variety of the Matchless Type; quite popular with Canners.
Chalk's Early Jewel20	A fine early variety, about 10 days later than Earliana; fruit uniformly smooth, round and solid. Color crimson.
