**TERMS**

Thirty days net to parties of approved credit established in advance of shipment, discount for cash in advance of shipment 3%; 2% for payment within 10 days; 30 days net. C.O.D. orders must be accompanied by  $\frac{1}{4}$  cash deposit. Boxing and baling are charged for at cost. When cash accompanies order, boxing will be billed to those of established credit, otherwise boxing charges will be sent C.O.D. with shipment.
