Bearded Iris comes in a wide range of colors. It blooms during a longer period than many flowers, and is equally good for garden effects or for cutting, being especially adapted for use in flower arrangement. Iris is a hardy perennial and requires a minimum of care.

These varieties have been selected for their moderate cost, and to thrive in almost any part of this country. They bear flowers from four to six inches high on stems varying from two to four feet tall.

Fine strong rhizomes, produced in the long growing season of California, are ready for shipment from June 15 throughout the fall. Those ordered early will have the best chance of becoming well established in your garden before winter weather. Cultural suggestions are sent upon request, or in acknowledgement of each order.
