The tulips in our list are Holland bulbs from a grower whose reputation is of the best. The varieties are carefully selected. The bulbs are guaranteed to be of highest quality and are top size, except as noted.

The daffodils are principally of our own growing, supplemented by Holland grown bulbs of a few varieties which are not yet generally available in this country.

In order to make certain of getting the varieties desired, orders should be placed early, during June or July, if possible. The bulbs will be sent to you in time for planting during October.

All prices are prepaid. Six or more bulbs of the same variety may be purchased at the dozen rate. Twenty-five or more of the same variety may be purchased at the one hundred rate. No order amounting to less than \$3.00 will be accepted.
