While we do not recommend the use of grafted Hibiseus where it is possible to grow the variety on its own root, there are some varieties that produce more abundant and better blooms if grafted on another more hardier root stock, the following Hibiseus are all grafted plants strong and healthy, they represent the pick of all our varieties.
