

CITRUS TREES FOR WINTER AND SPRING



The months of January, February and March are the best of the year for planting citrus. You who are planning to set cleared acreages or reset skips in old groves will find it advisable to make counts and place your orders for trees immediately. Again this year you will find the widest selection of varieties and root stocks of top quality trees at our nursery. We have grown over 100,000 trees on Rough Lemon, Sour Orange, Sweet Lemon, and Cleo root from which you can make your selection. Rootstocks are from 3 to 4 years old and the buds, ranging from ½ in. to 1½ in. in caliper, are 1 and 2 years old. As in years past, you will find that our careful selection of budwood from high quality, heavy-bearing trees have produced truly superior trees. Remember, we guarantee all of our trees to be true to name, in good condition and to have a good root system.

The following varieties are available:

ORANGES: Hamlin, Parson Brown, Pineapple, Jaffa, Valencia, Lue Gim Gong, Temple, Surprise Navel, Summerfield Navel, Clementine.

GRAPEFRUIT: Duncan, Marsh Seedless, Thompson Pink.

TANGELOS: Orlando, Seminole, Minneola.

OTHER VARIETIES: Dancy Tangerine, Persian Lime, Meiwa and Nagami Kumquats, Calamondin, Meyer, Avon and Ponderosa Lemons.

Our prices range from 75c to \$1.20 a tree, depending upon variety, size, and quantity desired. Our latest price list is enclosed; however, for this planting season we are further reducing the price on large size trees of the following varieties on Rough Lemon root stock only: Hamlin, Parson Brown, Jaffa oranges; and Duncan and Marsh grapefruit.
