### For Fall Planting and Spring Beauty

**DARWIN TULIPS** have tall strong stems, attractive colors and perfect cup-shaped blossoms. They bloom in May and average 20-30 inches tall.

  - BARTIGON—crimson-red
  - CLARA BUTT—soft salmon pink
  - CITY OF HAARLEM—vermilion-scarlet
  - ECLIPSE—brilliant deep crimson

  - PRINCESS ELIZABETH—bright pink
  - PRIDE OF HAARLEM—brilliant carmine rose
  - PRIDE OF ZWANENBURG—old rose
  - RED MASTER—deep red

  - van ZYL—rosy pink
  - WILLIAM PITT—scarlet, tinged orange
  - YELLOW GIANT—golden yellow

**COTTAGE TULIPS** also called May-Flowering are a trifle later than Darwins and have slightly less sturdy but tall stems.

  - NORTHERN QUEEN—white, edged pink

**SINGLE EARLY TULIPS** bloom in April with bright colored flowers on stems 12 to 15 inches tall.

  - WHITE HAWK—white

**DOUBLE EARLY TULIPS** bloom just ahead of the Darwins, on stems about a foot tall. Their double flowers resemble Peonies.

**BOTANICAL TULIPS** (tulipa species) all bloom early and have bright colors.

**PARROT TULIPS** have brilliantly colored, irregularly shaped flowers which are fringed, deeply cut, and frequently spotted with green.

**TRUMPET NARCISSI** have trumpets which are as long or longer than the outer petals. The stems are strong and about a foot tall.

**INCOMPARABILIS NARCISSI** have trumpets medium length, one-third of the full length of the outer petals

**SCILLA COMPANULATA** grow about 15 inches high, erect flower spikes with small bell-shaped blossoms which appear in early May.

**SNOWDROPS** are small pendant flowers on stems 3 or 4 inches tall. They bloom very early.
