

AFTERGLOW—salmon-pink, tinged orange BARTIGON-crimson-red CLARA BUTT—soft salmon pink CITY OF HAARLEM—vermilion-scarlet ECLIPSE—brilliant deep crimson GIANT-purple-violet LA TULIPE NOIRE—maroon-black PRINCESS ELIZABETH—bright pink PRIDE OF HAARLEM—brilliant carmine rose PRIDE OF ZWANENBURG-old rose RED MASTER-deep red TELESCORPIUM-violet van ZYL—rosy pink WILLIAM PITT—scarlet, tinged orange YELLOW GIANT-golden yellow ZWANENBURG-white **DOZEN \$1.00** PRICE **HUNDRED \$7.75** Rainbow Mixture Dozen 90<sup>e</sup> Hundred \$6.95 COTTAGE TULIPS also called May-Flowering are a trifle later than Darwins and have slightly less sturdy but tall stems. ADVANCED--orange-scarlet MARJORIE BOWEN-orange and buff MRS. JOHN T. SCHEEPERS—light canary yellow NORTHERN QUEEN—white, edged pink WHITE CITY—white **DOZEN \$1.00** PRICE HUNDRED \$7.75 SINGLE EARLY TULIPS bloom in April with bright col-ored flowers on stems 12 to 15 inches tall. GENERAL de WET-golden orange GOLDEN MASCOT-pure yellow IBIS-shades of rose and pink KEIZERSKROON-red with yellow border WHITE HAWK-white PRICE **DOZEN \$1.25** HUNDRED \$9.00 DOUBLE EARLY TULIPS bloom just ahead of the Darwins, on stems about a foot tall. Their double flowers resemble Peonies. ORANGE NASSAU-orange-scarlet, orange edge PEACH BLOSSOM-rosy pink VAN der HOEFF-pure yellow **DOZEN \$1.25** PRICE **HUNDRED \$9.00** BOTANICAL TULIPS (tulipa species) all bloom early and have bright colors. **RED EMPEROR**—brilliant scarlet DOZEN \$1.25 PRICE **HUNDRED \$9.00** PARROT TULIPS have brilliantly colored, irregularly shaped flowers which are fringed, deeply cut, and frequently splotched with green. BLUE PARROT-bright violet blue FANTASY—salmon-pink, mottled green ORANGE FANTASY—orange, yellow and green PRICE **DOZEN \$1.35 HUNDRED \$10.00** BREEDER TULIPS bloom a little later than the Darwins, have rich subdued tones on tall stems.
