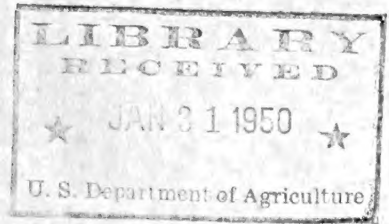

CYMBIDIUM ORCHID PLANTS

For the amateur as well as the professional, there is no finer flower, lasting for months as a cut flower, and none so easy to grow as the Cymbidium. We have grown these Orchids over a period of years under the following conditions: In Southern California we grow Cymbidiums out of doors under lath or tree shade, however, some of our friends grow them under glass, either one just so long as they have a good circulation of air but no direct wind. Cymbidium do well planted in raised beds or grown in pots. Plant high so the base of the pseudo bulbs are at surface level, mulch with leaf mold to keep the compost on the acid side. Cymbidium must have good drainage. We use a potting soil of 2 parts leaf mold, 1 part top soil and 1 part pea gravel or decomposed granite. Use plenty of broken pots or coarse gravel in the bottom of the pot.

We endeavor to keep the following in stock at all times, as we consider these plants essential in every collection. They are all free bloomers and strong growers. These plants are plant divisions from plants that have bloomed and should bloom again in the next blooming season. In some cases there are smaller divisions, consequently we have given you a choice of size of plant and price; in some cases we have only a back bulb for sale, as prices indicate.

Cymbidium back bulbs are removed from adult plants. These bulbs sprout and form new plants, reproducing the identical flowers of the adult plant. All bulbs are strong and healthy and should do well if growing instructions are followed. Whenever possible we ship sprouted bulbs.

CYPRIPEDIUM ORCHID PLANTS

CYPRIPEDIUM: (Lady Slipper Orchid) This beautiful waxy flower has a pouch that has given it the name of Lady Slipper Orchid. These lovely evergreen plants can be grown outdoors in a warm climate where the temperature does not drop below freezing, or may be grown as house plants. The flowers are many-colored: green, yellow, brown, deep tones of red and purple and a few rare whites. The flower will last on the plant for months in perfect condition.

RARE PLANT LIST

In our gardens we grow many rare and unusual plants. In the majority these are shade plants that grow out of doors in California where the temperature usually stays above freezing. These plants are also excellent house plants, grown in pots, baskets or planters. The demand has been so great from our visitors that we have found it necessary to propagate, and offer you the following established plants:-

IVY: We consider IVY a necessary plant -hardy, will grow in full sun or shade and needs no special soil. Ivy makes fine ground cover, will trellis or trail, does well in an indoor planter. Make dish-washing a pleasure by trailing them around your kitchen window.

CALIFORNIA SELF-BRANCHING IVY: a very good small leaf variety, always has two shades of green growth, the new growth is a bright light green and the older growth deep velvety green color -15¢ ea.

HAHN'S SELF-BRANCHING IVY: A very good grower in deep green, the leaf is like a small maple leaf ..... 15¢ ea.

FAN SELF-BRANCHING IVY: THIS IS NEW AND RARE. The leaves are small fans, fine grower, the ribs are light green, rest of leaf is a beautiful soft green - most attractive ..... 25¢ ea.

GLACIER IVY: Very new and spectacular, a miniature variety of white and green, wonderful for dish gardens or small planters, attracts attention anywhere ..... 35¢ ea.

CALIFORNIA GOLD LEAF IVY: a fine miniature with variegated gold leaves ..... 50¢ ea.

HOYA: If you haven't seen the Hoya vine in bloom, you have missed a most unusual bloom. The flowers look as though they were carved out of ivory, blooming in an umbel, each little flower a symphony of delight - the leaves are fleshy and waxy. Grow in shade, requiring an acid soil.

SPATHIPHYELUM: These plants are grown as house plants in many localities. It is of the Anthurium family, being hardy, with good green foliage. The flower is shell white, most attractive, lasting for weeks. Used in corsages. Plants are easy to grow, give acid soil. TWO SIZES.....\$2.00 and \$3.00 each.

ZYGO CACTUS: (Xmas Cactus) Blooms at Christmas with many red flowers, an old-fashioned favorite for an east window.....Plants 50¢ ea.

KENTIA PALMS: The ever-popular house palm. Easily grown, adapts itself to house conditions. Do not over-water. Limited number 75¢ ea

BILLBERGIA: Have stiff leaves forming a tube from which the flower panicles appear. A most interesting plant, often called "living vases", as they hold water in the tubular formation. Easy to grow in soil or moss - simply keep water in the tube:
