Terms and Information

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Discount Plan Where cash is required in full payment of Fall orders by September 15th, and on Spring orders by March 15th, a 2% discount will be allowed.

Open Account Goods will be supplied open account to customers of approved credit who supply satisfactory trade and bank references. Time must be allowed for investigation. Terms are 2% 10 days, net 30 days.

C.O.D. Orders All C.O.D. orders must be accompanied with a one-third down payment.

Note When retail customers are sent to the sales yard to buy on a wholesale account, they must have either a letter or purchase order from the firm sending them. The discount on sales of this kind is 25% off the retail.

SHIPPING SEASONS

The Fall season usually begins about the 15th of September or at the time when we have had sufficient rain to put the ground in the proper condition for digging. The Fall season usually closes November 15th.

The Spring season begins just as soon as all of the frost is out of the ground—usually around April 1st. By May 15th, the stock is normally too far out in growth to transplant successfully.

The prices in this catalog are limited to the Fall of '51 and the Spring of '52. This printing

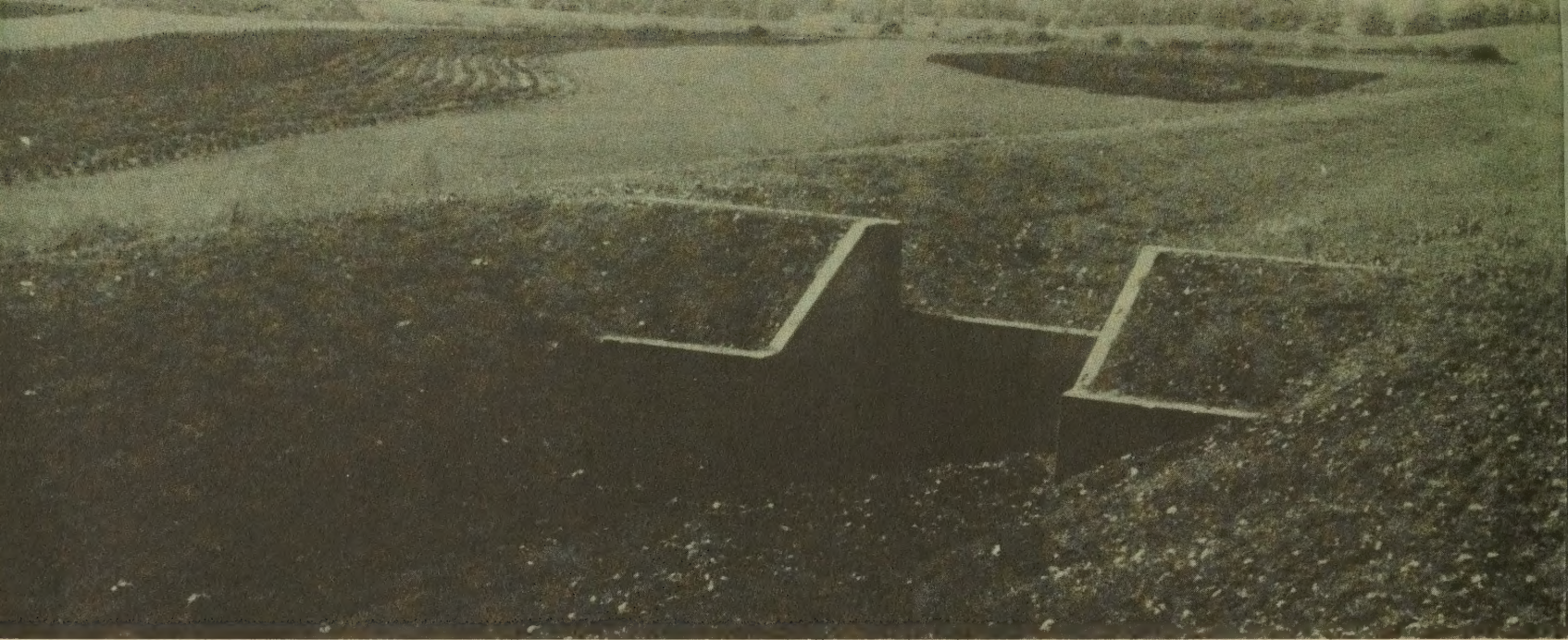

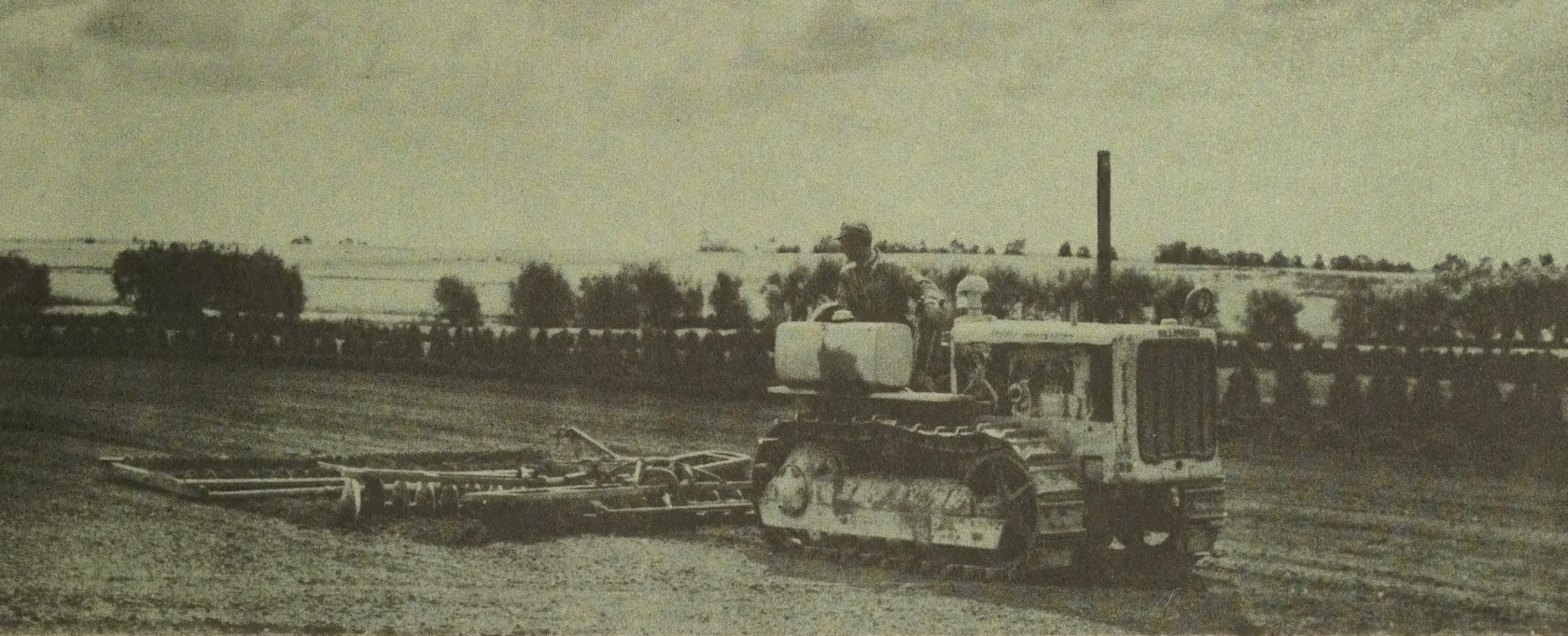

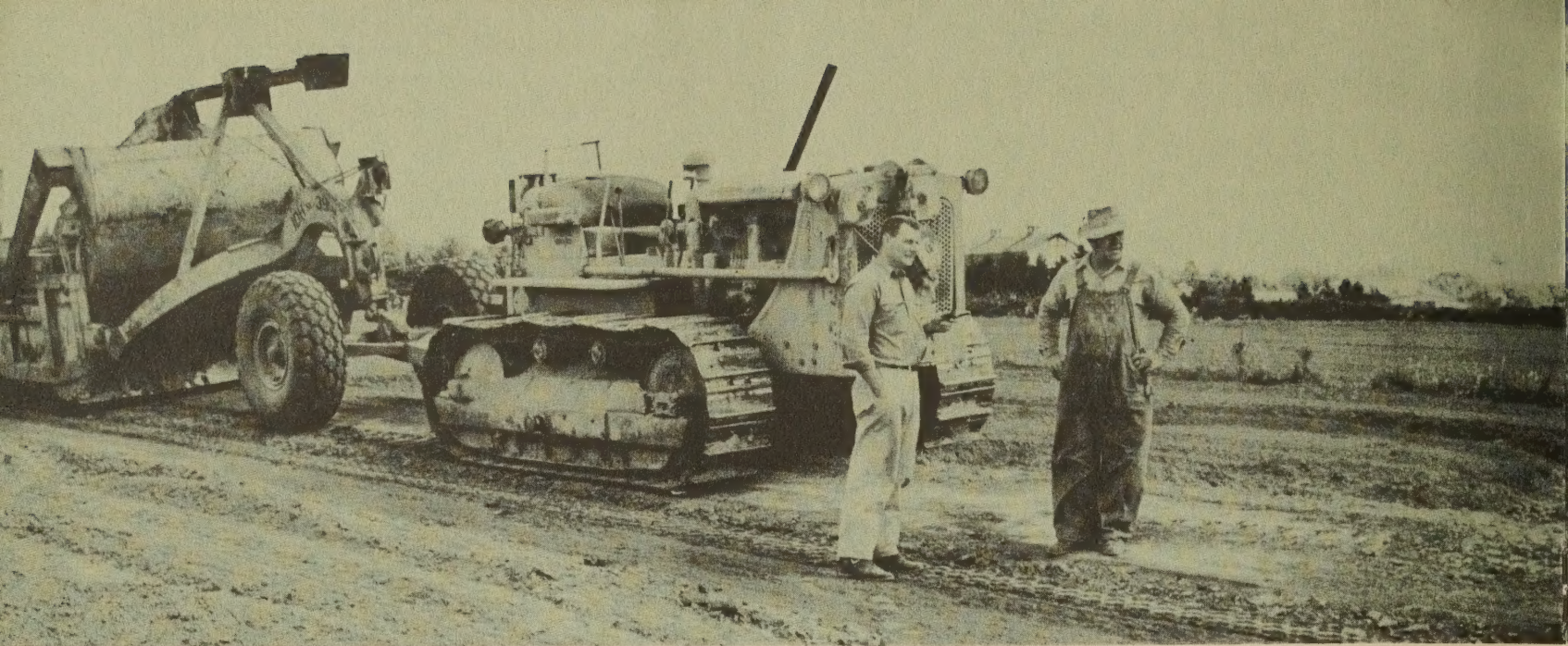

PRE-STAKED EVERGREEN GRAFTS

Our grafts are ready for field planting and cultivation when shipped—no grafts broken in shipping or cultivation—no expensive staking or tying necessary.

Before your graft is shipped from Hill's, a light but strong stake is inserted into each pot beside the graft. The rubber strip is replaced with grafting tape that encircles both the stake and the graft, and the tip of each graft is secured to the stake with a patent tie. The pot itself is then replaced with a light-weight, moisture-proof

wrapping to save shipping expense and to insure that the graft reaches you in the best possible condition.

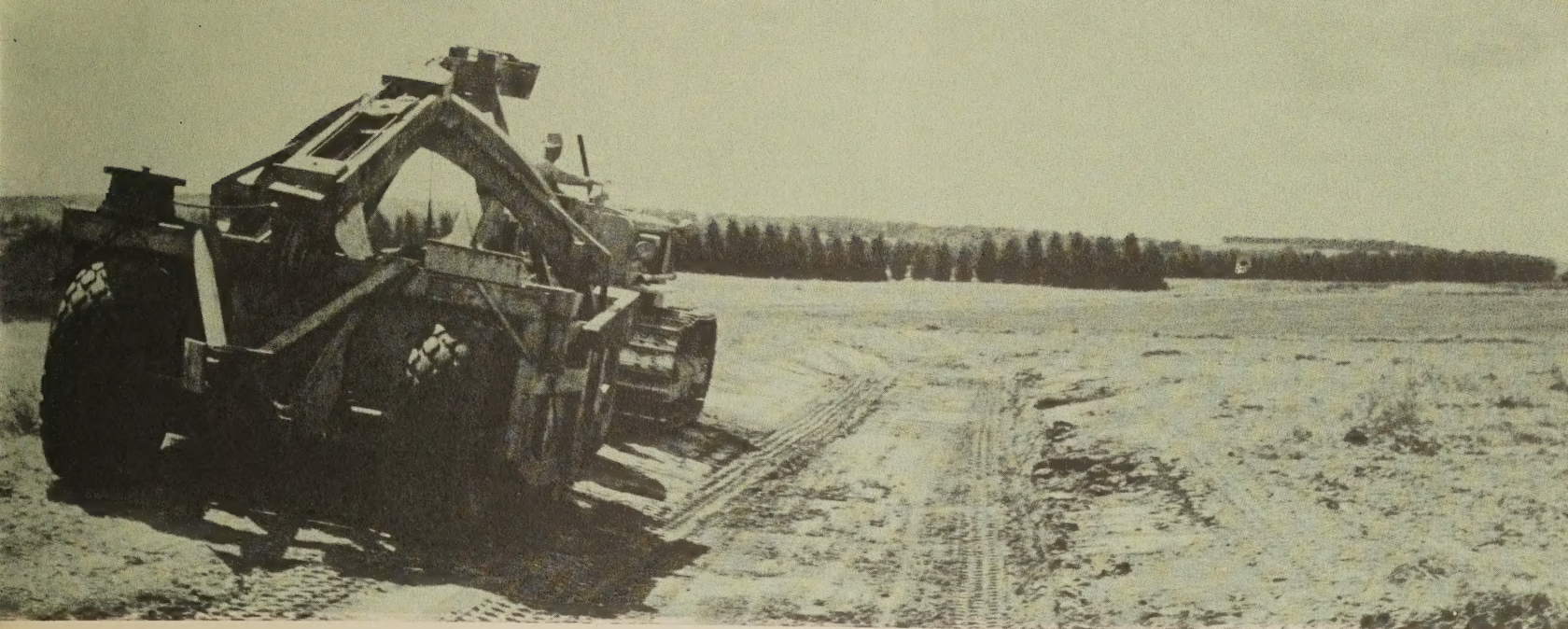

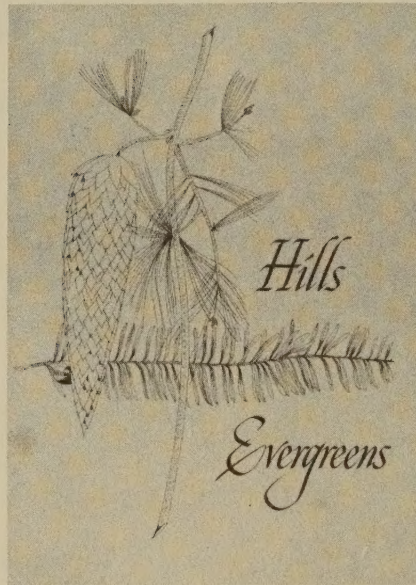
