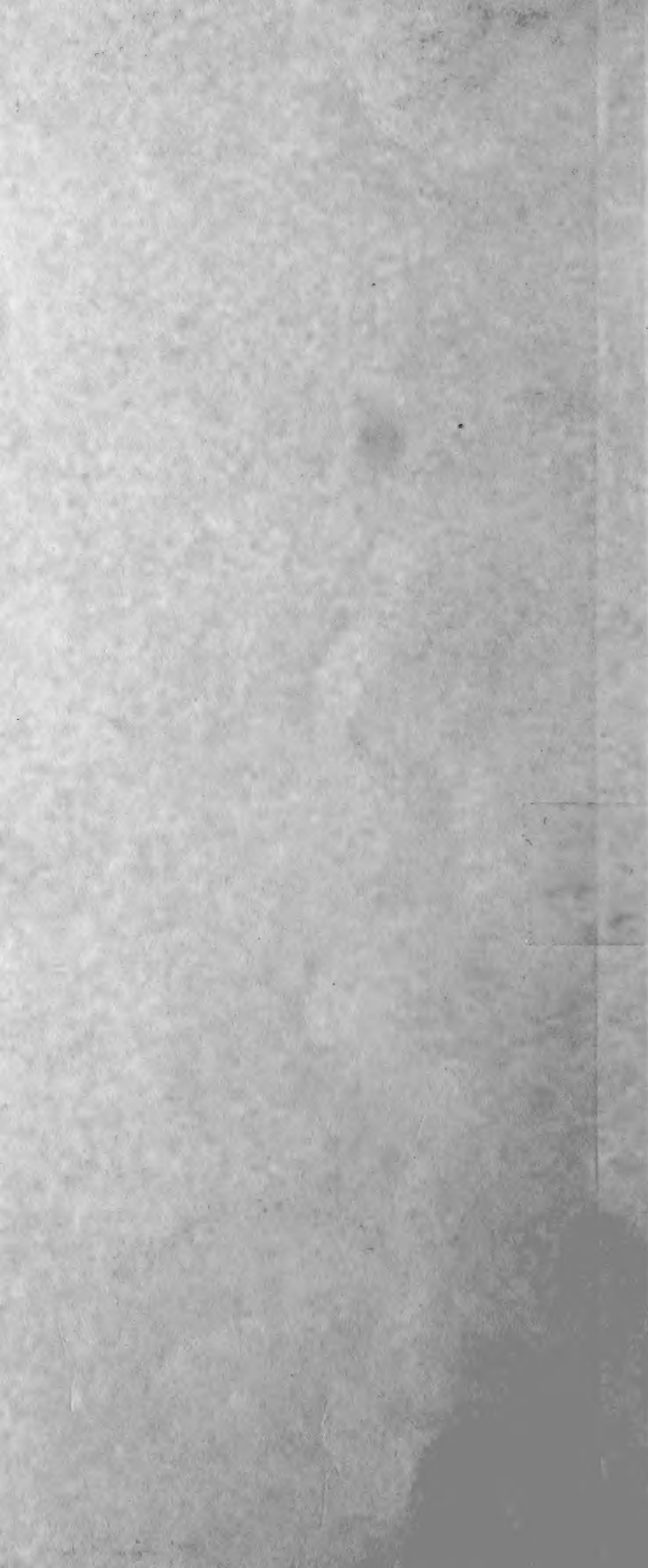

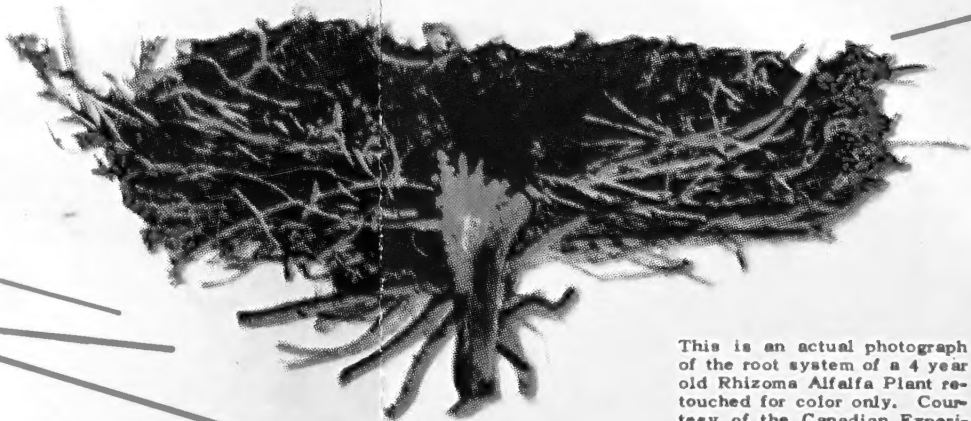
**MORE GRAZING** The crown is below the ground surface - so the plant cannot be injured by overgrazing or trampling. Stands actually thicken with grazing. Competes with grass.

**MORE HAY** Rhizoma Alfalfa stands up to 42 in. high. In actual tests - out-yielded Grimm with leafier, finer alfalfa of higher protein.

**LESS SEED NEEDED** Plant only 1/4 the seed you normally plant in your area!

**GREATEST RESISTANCE TO WINTER KILLING** In tests north of the Canadian Peace Valley it survived:

- (1) 60° below zero temperatures
- (2) Flooding
- (3) Ice sheets
