We will CHEM-COAT your alfalfa, clovers or grasses for 2¢ per pound (\$2.00 per 100 pounds) over and above listed prices. CHEM-COATING gives full protection against seed and soil born diseases. Its results are more noticeable with lower grade seeds than on top grades. Certified seed cannot be treated as we do not like to break the seal.

## PREPARE ALFALFA SEED-BED CAREFULLY

Have plenty of moisture to develop the plants after they start, and do not plant too deep.

Ground worked down until it is firm underneath and finely pulverized on top, seeded at the rate of 10 to 15 pounds to the acre, will give a better stand than a seeding of twice that amount on poorly prepared ground.

These four rules will insure a stand under normal conditions:—(1) Work seed-bed until it is firm beneath. A tiny alfalfa root cannot bridge an air pocket.

(2) Have surface soil finely pulverized. Germination will be poor unless particles pack tightly around seeds.

(3) Seed shallow. Few seeds covered more than three-fourth of an inch will push through. Surface seeding followed by rolling is about the best method.

(4) Be sure there is enough moisture for prompt germination and development of the plant.

### RED TOP GRASS

Starts early in spring and grows vigorously till late fall. Will grow on soils low in lime, is next to Reeds Canary Grass for wet land, and is also drought resistant. It germinates quickly and is easy to get a stand, maturing hay at about the same time as Timothy. Makes quick pasture, good for prevention of soil erosion or waterways, it will stand close grazing and trampling. Well adapted over a wide area. Sow in early spring or fall at rate of 10 pounds per acre alone or 5 pounds per acre in mixtures.

### PERENNIAL RYE GRASS

The quickest growing grass. A perennial, it lives over winter. Not as long lived as some grasses but starts earlier in spring and grows rapidly to provide early feed and to form a quick sod while other grasses are getting started. We also have the Annual Rye Grass that matures in one season.

### BUFFALO GRASS (Treated)

A low-growing, long lived, extremely drought resistant perennial grass which spreads by surface runners. Forms a dense sod and withstands lots of abuse. Supplies a palatable and nutritious pasture. Sow 8 pounds per acre for successful pasture by end of second season. For quicker pasture, sow 15 to 20 pounds per acre in 7 inch drill rows. Mixes well with Blue Grama using 10 pounds Buffalo and 15 pounds Blue Grama per acre. This seed has had the soaking and chilling treatment to promote better and quicker germination.

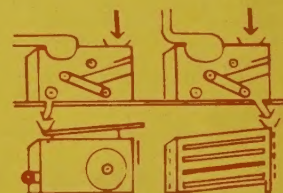
