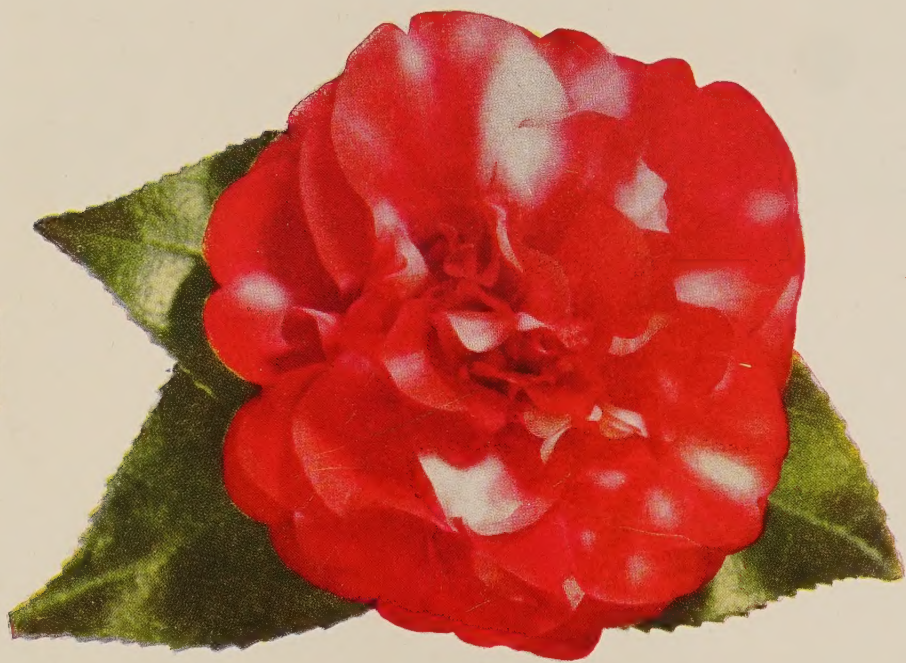

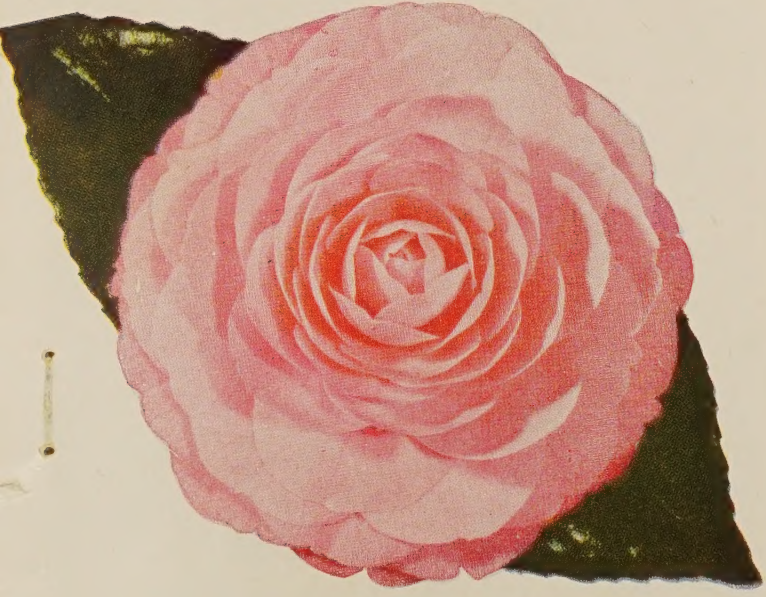

Example: Chandleri Elegans

Peony Form - A deep rounded flower with several rows of outer petals, the center a convex mass of twisted petaloids and stamens. Example: Debutante

Rose Form - Imbricated petals, showing stamens in a concave center when fully open. Example: Purity

Formal Double - Fully imbricated, many rows of petals never showing stamens. Example: Alba Plena

Southern States - In compliance with the quarantine regulations of some of the Southern States Camellias imported from California. Our camellias are carefully washed of all soil and the "bare-roots" are packed in damp sphagnum moss and wrapped in oil paper. The plants are then packed in sealed corrugated cartons. This method of packing assures a moist root-system upon arrival.

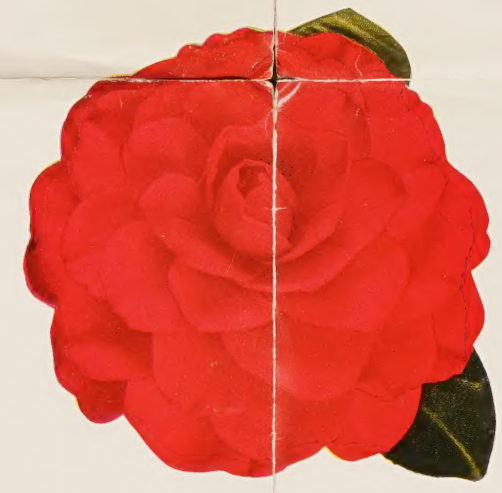

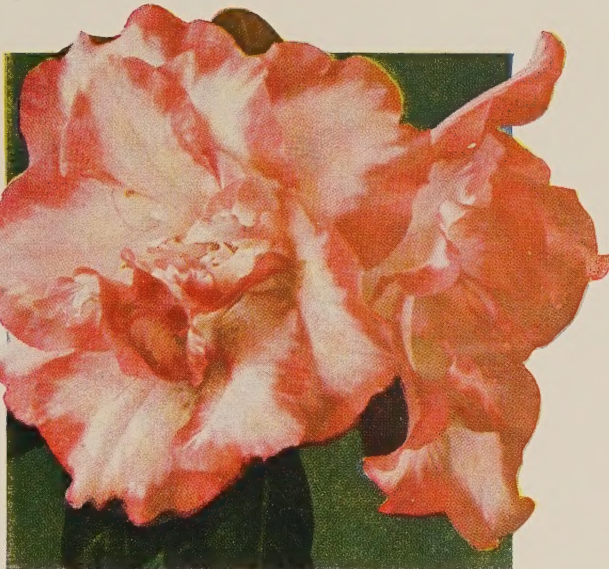
