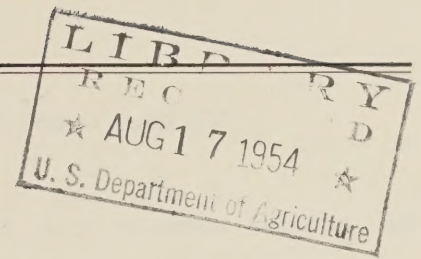

Because of improved methods in grafting we are now in a position to offer a better supply of Tree Peonies and in greater quantity and variety than ever before. Tree Peonies are unusually beautiful because of their immense flowers and large selection of colors that are distinctly different. Not only do they possess the finest shades of pink, red, and white, but also develop flowers of pure yellow, yellow and orange, lavender, violet, and purple.

Tree Peonies are perfectly hardy and will thrive in the same soil and location as the regular herbaceous type; rich sandy-loam, well-drained. They like well-decayed manure and bonemeal.

We are able to supply 2 year 5" pot plants as well as field plants. Pot plants can be shipped any time; field plants are shipped in fall or early spring.
