
Oat crops likewise are very disappointing due to unfavorable weather conditions. We therefore advise early purchases.

Cut or grazed, combined with small grains, or seeded alone, it furnishes splendid winter and spring pasture. Makes wonderful hay which all stock relish; very rich in protein. Stands drought and severe winters without injury. Does surprisingly well on all types of soils. Sow during August through October at the rate of 20 lbs. per acre in drills or 30 lbs. broadeast. Inoculate with Nitragin.

DWARF ESSEX RAPE - Although it is not a soil-builder, it is something every hog and poultry raiser should plant. Pork can be produced at a lower cost if pastured on Rape. Makes fine "greens" for table use as a substitute for turnip, spinach and the like. Grows on any soil and makes a splendid forage crop in 6 to 8 weeks. Broadcast at the rate of 8 to 12 lbs. per acre any time during the fall, winter or spring.
